Extend the 4 indicators (lines 12 to 15), to 9, aligning with the classes of biotic ecosystems outputs of the common classification of ecosystem services (CICES) (https://cices.eu/content/uploads/sites/8/2018/03/Finalised-V5.1_18032018.xlsx) |
| 2 | 8 | B | 16-25 | Include number of large dams as an indicator of fragmentation |
| 2 | 27 | B | 1 to 9 | Mere references to “biodiversity” in the policies and regulations are not enough. Consider the inclusion of “Legal indicators of effectivity of norms” (Prieur, Michel 2018 https://drive.google.com/file/d/1JKpaDWGAF-HbBqo7aEU6qTy3aURu4tO7/view?usp=sharing) |
| 2 | 27 | C | 23 to 27 | Include removal of abandoned dams as an indicator of water stress reduction. |
| 2 | 31 | C | 7 to 11 | Include removal of abandoned dams as an indicator of water stress reduction. |
| 2 | 31 | C | 20 to 26 | Consider also number of policies and regulations that refer to protection of cultural ecosystem services. |
