- Broader engagement in implementing the CBD and better understanding of biodiversity issues by subnational and local gvts
- Sub national and local gvts encouraged to prepare Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans in line with NBSAPs

- Coordination: Parties, Global Partnership, Advisory Committees, regional partners
- Monitoring and evaluation: GBO-like assessment, City Biodiversity Index as part of the indicator framework
- Funding difficulties and how to overcome: ICLEI/LAB platform, role of each GP participant, decentralized cooperation

- -Japan will support regional and subregional workshops for the review of the NBSAPs, SCBD plans to involve nrg4SD and ICLEI


