Internal Cooperation Agreement (ICA)

A. Introduction and Background

This Internal Cooperation Agreement is executed between [Requesting/Funding Division] and [Implementing Division] (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties") on (date).

- 1. Requesting/Funding Division: Division of Environmental Law and Conventions (UNEP DELC), represented by its Director, Mr. Bakary Kante;
- 2. Implementing Division: Secretariat to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), represented by its Executive Secretary Braulio Dias.

This agreement is concluded between the CBD Secretariat and UNEP as part of a set of individual agreements between MEAs and UNEP to implement the InforMEA project funded through the ENRTP process (Project Document Appendix 1). The following generic Items for inclusion in Agreement between UNEP and MEA Secretariats have been developed by the MEA IKM Working Group and endorsed by the 4th MEA IKM Steering Committee Meeting held in Montreux, Switzerland on 4-6 June 2013

The CBD Secretariat has been pioneering the development and initial implementation of the Application Programming Interface (API) and been instrumental in the development of the voluntary formats and standards now shared by MEAs. Currently, the CBD Secretariat is in the process of strengthening its information exchange platform to better serve its Parties and partners. In this context, the CBD Secretariat and the MEA-IKM initiative share common goals, and the MEA ENRTP will contribute to their achievements.

B. Project Overview

Objectives

Data preparation and management, technical implementation, participation in the development of common terminology and outreach activities in order to contribute to the implementation of the ENRTP InforMEA project.

Data preparation and management

- Overall adherence to format and schemas as negotiated by the MEA IKM Initiative
- Core MEA information (Treaty articles, Parties, National Focal Points, Decisions & Recommendations, Meetings, Reports & Plans, Announcements) through the implementation and maintenance of the InforMEA API at the CBD Secretariat.
- Presentation of historical data on national reports and plans dating back to the first National Report.
- E-learning, guidance and capacity building materials (webinars, courses, etc)

Technical implementation

Cooperation between CBD technical staff and the technical service providers of the MEA IKM Initiative for the duration of this project.

Participation in the development of the Thesaurus/Controlled vocabulary

Participation through a designated focal point in the development/refinement of the Thesaurus and the mapping of the MEA-specific terminology to the same.

Outreach

Participation in joint outreach efforts including the placement of the InforMEA Applet in the homepage and/or the decisions search page and other categories of information, as appropriate.

C. Activities under this Agreement

The elements below constitute the main activities related to this agreement:

1. Data preparation and management

- Comprehensively maintain the InforMEA API as developed through the MEA IKM Initiative
 with strong contribution by CBD and already implemented by CBD for COP decisions, national
 focal points, meetings and events. Regularly test and review the full functionality of the
 service. Fully implement the identified new categories of information, in particular NBSAPs
 and national reports.
- Identify and collate a set of training and capacity materials suitable for translation into elearning modules for inclusion in the InforMEA e-learning facility. Participate in the development of an InforMEA standard on document libraries related to e-learning applications.

2. Participation in the development of the Thesaurus/Controlled vocabulary

Participate through a designated focal point in the development/refinement of the Thesaurus and the mapping of CBD-specific terminology in collaboration with the UNEP and MEA information specialists.

3. Outreach

Participation in joint outreach efforts including the placement of the InforMEA link or applet on relevant pages of the CBD website.

- iii) Implement the Project in accordance with standard UNEP Rules and established business processes.
- iv) Produce Results-Based reports to [UNEP DELC] under Clause 2.
- 4. This Internal Cooperation Agreement may be terminated by either Party by giving two months prior notice in writing.
- 5. Any part of this Agreement can be changed and be effective only through an agreed modification in writing by the Parties.
- 6. The Parties shall carry out their respective responsibilities in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement. The Parties shall determine and communicate to each other their respective focal points, having the responsibility for the Project implementation on its behalf.
