

## **SAINT LUCIA SECOND NBSAP:**

**The new vision is that:**

***Biodiversity management is an integral part of the overall framework of environmental management, for ensuring sustainable social, cultural and economic development in Saint Lucia; and that there is collective responsibility for, and sharing in the benefits derived from the conservation and sustainable use of biological resources”.***

**Hence, the goal for 2008 – 2018 is that :**

***“Conservation and sustainable practices for use of biological diversity in Saint Lucia are effectively integrated into national development at all levels”.***
