The meetings will start at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 27 November, and registration will take place at the venue of the meetings at 8:30 a.m. the same day.

# 5. GENERAL INFORMATION ON ACCESS TO BOGOTA, COLOMBIA

Bogota is serviced by the El Dorado International Airport (13 km from downtown). Taxis are available at the airport at a cost of about US \$6.00 -10.00 and the journey takes about 30-40 minutes. It is recommended to book taxis within the terminal to pay fixed rates. The **Habitel Hotel** offers a free shuttle service to and from the airport, please contact the hotel directly for arrangements.

Please note that there is a departure tax of about US \$38 for international flights leaving Colombia which must be paid in cash in US dollars or in Colombia pesos (approx. COP 115,000).

# 6. VISA INFORMATION

Colombia and all other participants are strongly advised to contact the nearest Colombian diplomatic or consular mission as soon as possible in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. Please note that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

# 11. WEATHER AND TIME ZONE INFORMATION

The standard time zone is GMT/UTC -5 hours.

The electrical currents in Colombia are 110-120 volts, 60 Hertz as shown in the illustrations below.



# 13. CURRENCY



The currency in Colombia is the Colombian Pesos (COP). The current exchange rate as at 9 November 2017 is US \$1 = COP 3,009.95 and (Euro)  $$\in 1 = \text{COP } 3,504.66$ .

Currency exchange facilities are available in banks and hotels, local currency can be obtained on most ATM machines.
