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1. Opening and registration

The Subregional dialogue on national biodiversity strategies and action plans for Caribbean countries and the Subregional workshop on Target 3 of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework for Caribbean countries, hosted by Caribbean Community (CARICOM) Secretariat, in Georgetown, Guyana from Monday, 15 April to Friday, 19 April 2024

The dialogue and workshop will start at 9:00 a.m. on 15 April 2024. Registration will take place at the venue of the workshop from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. the same day.

5. General information on access to Georgetown, Guyana



The city of Georgetown is serviced by the Cheddi Jagan International Airport (41 km from downtown) and the Ogle International Airport (12 km from downtown). More information about the airports can be found at: <http://www.cjairport-gy.com/> and <http://www.ogleairportguyana.com/>

Participants are responsible for arranging their own transportation between the airport and the hotel. You are advised to use the official airport taxis upon arrival in Guyana. The transportation costs are included in your per diem allowance. The average taxi fare from the Cheddi Jagan International Airport to the Pegasus Hotel is approximately US \$50.00 and approximately US \$15 from the Ogle International Airport.

6. Visa information



Participants requiring an entry visa for Guyana will receive assistance from the CARICOM Secretariat. To facilitate the request the following requirements must be submitted to the CARICOM Secretariat at least six weeks prior to the participant's arrival:

1. Copy of Passport Biodata Page
2. Passport size photo
3. Return Electronic Ticket
4. Completed Visa Application Form (See **Attachment I**)

All participants must travel with a passport valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry into the country.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue, upon request, invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

7. Travel and Health requirements

All participants should ensure compliance with the travel requirements for Guyana (see Guidelines for travelling to Guyana – CJIA (www.cjairport-gy.com), and in-transit Countries prior to travel. It is also recommended that participants ensure that their Yellow Fever vaccination, which should be part of their travel documentation, was issued within the last ten years.

8. Hotel information

Participants are kindly reminded that they have to **MAKE THEIR OWN HOTEL RESERVATIONS as soon as possible**. A listing of hotels in the vicinity of the workshop venue can be found below in Annex I below.

9. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA)

Funded participants will receive their DSA on the first day of the workshop.

10. Official language in Guyana

The official language in Guyana is English.

11. Weather and time zone information



Guyana is a tropical country and during this period is likely to experience both sunny and rainy weather. Current weather conditions in the area can be found at: <http://www.worldweather.org/065/c00289.htm>.

The standard time zone will be GMT/UTC -4 hours.

12. Electricity

The electrical currents in Guyana are 110 and 240 Volts, 60 Hertz a (two-pin flat and vertical with a ground connection).



13. Currency



The currency in use in Guyana is the Guyanese Dollar (GYD). Participants are advised to consult the hotel receptionist for further advice on currency exchange if necessary. The approximate exchange rate is US \$1.00 = G\$200 (Guyanese Dollars) and 1€ = G\$195.

14. Safety

It is recommended that persons move around in groups, especially at night. When leaving the hotel, it is advisable to notify someone of your location and we suggest that you use authorized taxis whenever necessary.

15. Disclaimer

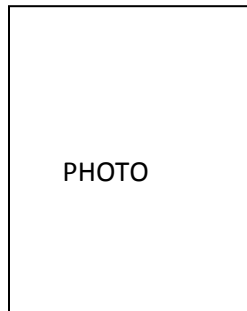
