Note by the Executive Secretary

- 1. As requested in decision NP-3/4 of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Nagoya Protocol, the Secretariat prepared a revised format for the first national report, which is contained in annex to the draft decision on monitoring and reporting (Article 29) in the compilation of draft decisions (CBD/NP/MOP/4/1/Add.5).
- 2. The present document provides additional information on the specific changes to questions contained in the format of the first national report, compared to the format used for the interim national report. The information is presented in tabular form and also includes reference to relevant indicators from the framework of indicators contained in annex II to decision NP-3/1 on the assessment and review of the effectiveness of the Protocol.
