Bhutan has developed a national CHM website but information flow is absolute limited and mainstreaming the process is an on-going dialogue happening.

There are many actors playing major roles in the conservation efforts and to certain level, the national task force creation for NBSAP has enabled a platform for better coordination among these actors, while the work on national CHM has been limited, further dialogues will be taking place to take the agenda forward.

Comments on roadmap

Then setting up the right team for CHM and mainstreaming it is the current priority. Once that is completed, upgradation of the current CHM will be proposed.
