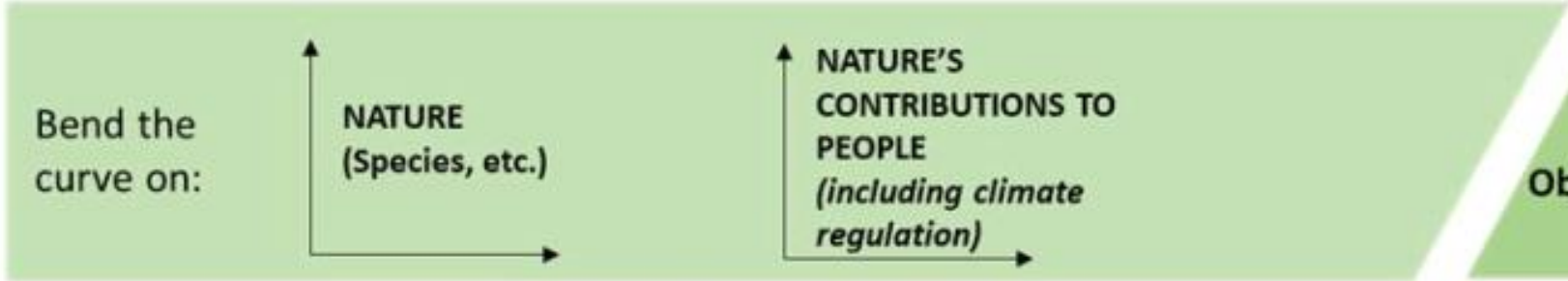

By 2030, halt the loss of biodiversity and put nature on a path to recovery for the benefit of all people and the planet

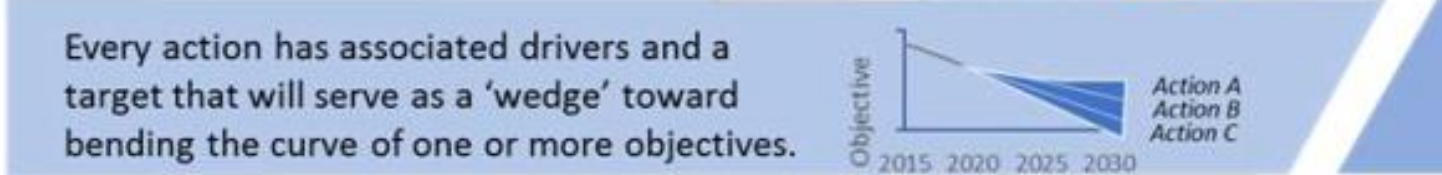

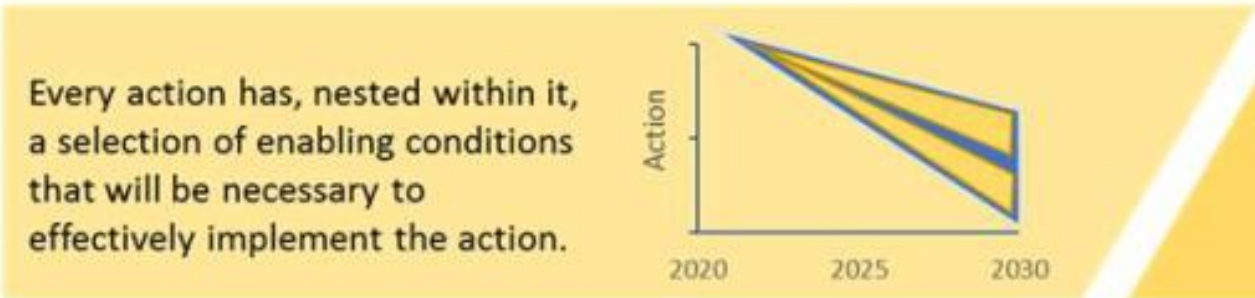

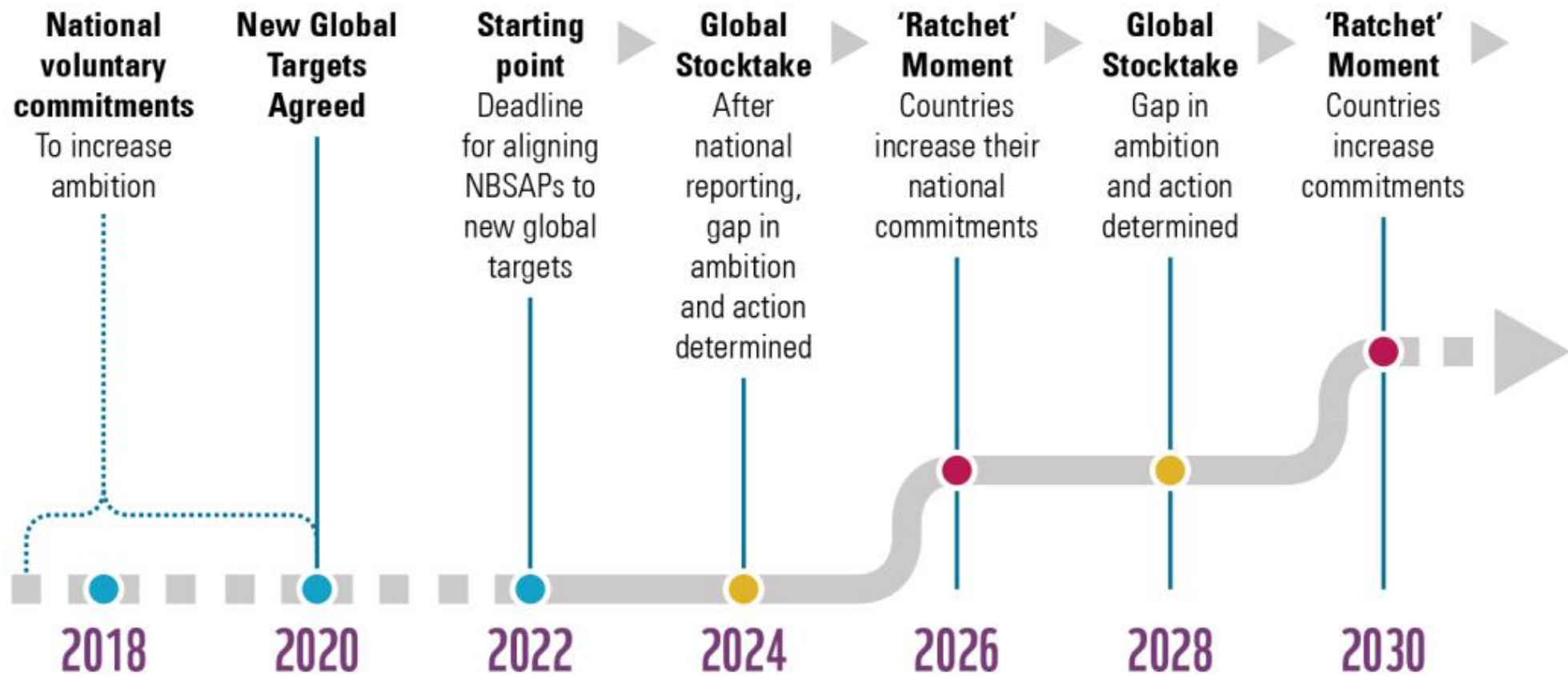

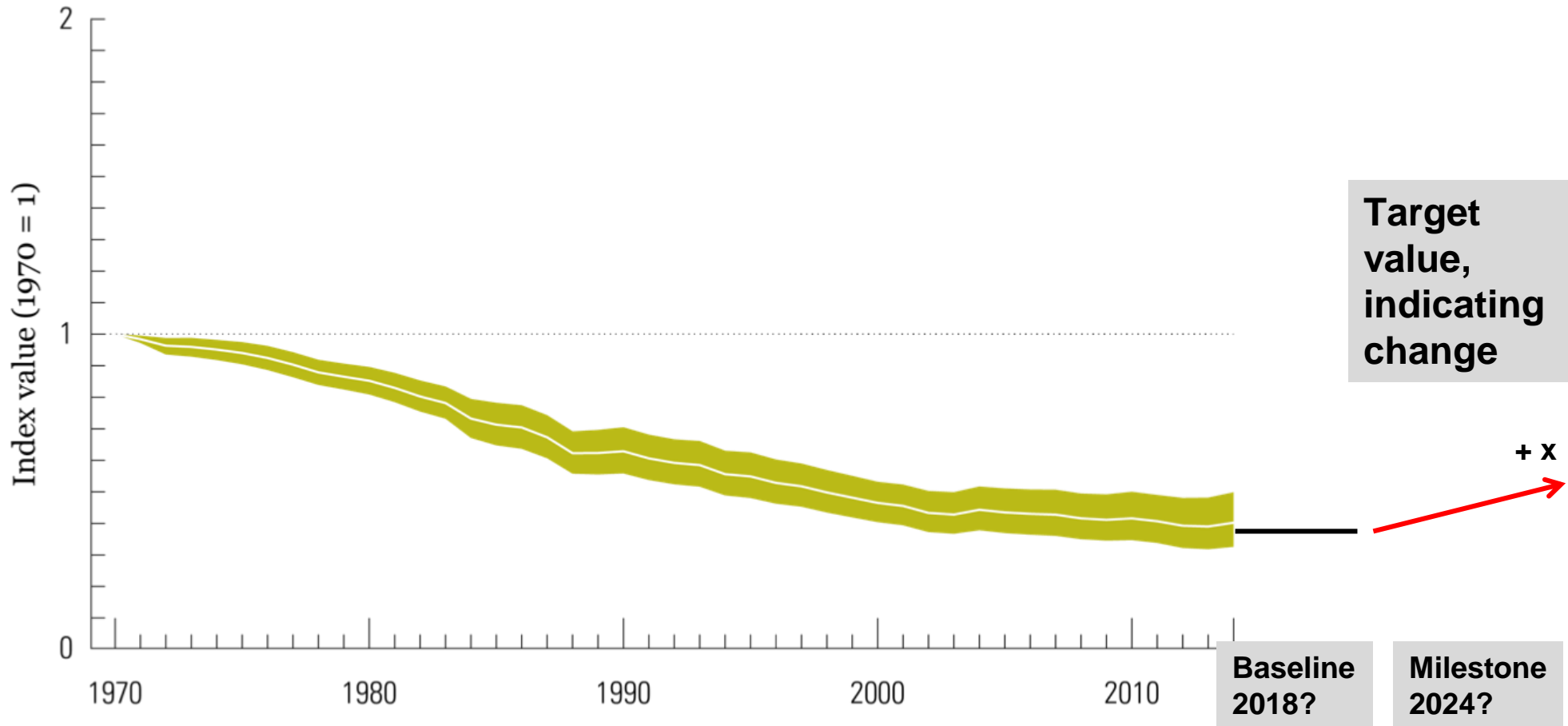
