

What is the High Ambition Coalition for Nature and People?

The HAC is an intergovernmental and interregional group of over 70 countries established to achieve an ambitious deal at the Convention on Biological Diversity in order to reverse the severe trend of biodiversity loss and revive ecosystems that are critical to species and humanity's survival



The Central Goal of the coalition is to ensure the inclusion and adoption of an ambitious language on protecting at least 30 percent of the world's land and ocean by 2030, at the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)

This increased target should promote indigenous –led conservation, prioritize intact ecosystems, and focus on areas most important for biodiversity and climate. The resulting network of conserved areas should be ecologically representative, well –connected, and maintain species diversity and abundance

Additional Goals of the HAC for Nature & People


1) the effective management of protected and conserved areas

2) increased public and private financing to ensure long-term management and local governance

3) clear implementation mechanisms to put nature on a path to recovery by 2030.

4) Increase synergies between CBD COP₁₅ and UNFCCC COP₂₆







Main messages from HAC TASK Force Narrative

- The adoption of the 30x30 target in the GBF is an opportunity to implement the commitments made under the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and to ensure an innovative approach to conservation that respects Indigenous rights and responsibilities, respects the rights of humans and nature, and engages IPLCs as full partners and leaders
- Moreover, by ensuring that the designation of protected areas and identification as OECMs including within the territories of IPLCs for biodiversity conservation is undertaken with free, prior and informed consent or approval and involvement, the 30x30 target will emphasize the role of IPLCs as the establishment and management of such protected and conserved areas
