- Policy of Gross National Happiness
- Conservation of Environment as one of the main pillars of GNH
- Has pledged to remain Carbon Neutral
- Constitution mandates to maintain at least 60% of the area under Forest Cover at all times
- Target to go 100 % Organic
- Many initiatives to generate support for conservation- "Bhutan for Life"
- Food Security, Poverty, Natural Disasters, Socio-Economic Development are the challenges (for Conservation)

- Mapping high biodiversity value habitats to understand the status of biodiversity (loss and fragmentation) – Target 5
- 2. Mapping key ecosystems and ecosystem services Target 14

- 4. Documentation of the genetic diversity of key domestic species & Threats (crops & animals)- Target 13
- 5. Assessment and generate information on conservation status of prioritized taxonomic groups- Target 12
- 6. Generation of science based knowledge and technologies on biodiversity through research (data and information on biodiversity) -Target 19
