Co-leads' proposals on target 17 of the global biodiversity framework: tools and solutions for implementation and mainstreaming

TARGET 17

Establish, strengthen capacity for, and implement measures in all countries to prevent, manage or control potential adverse impacts of living modified organisms resulting from biotechnology on biodiversity and human health, reducing the risk of these impacts, while recognizing the potential benefits of biotechnology towards achieving the objectives of the Convention.
