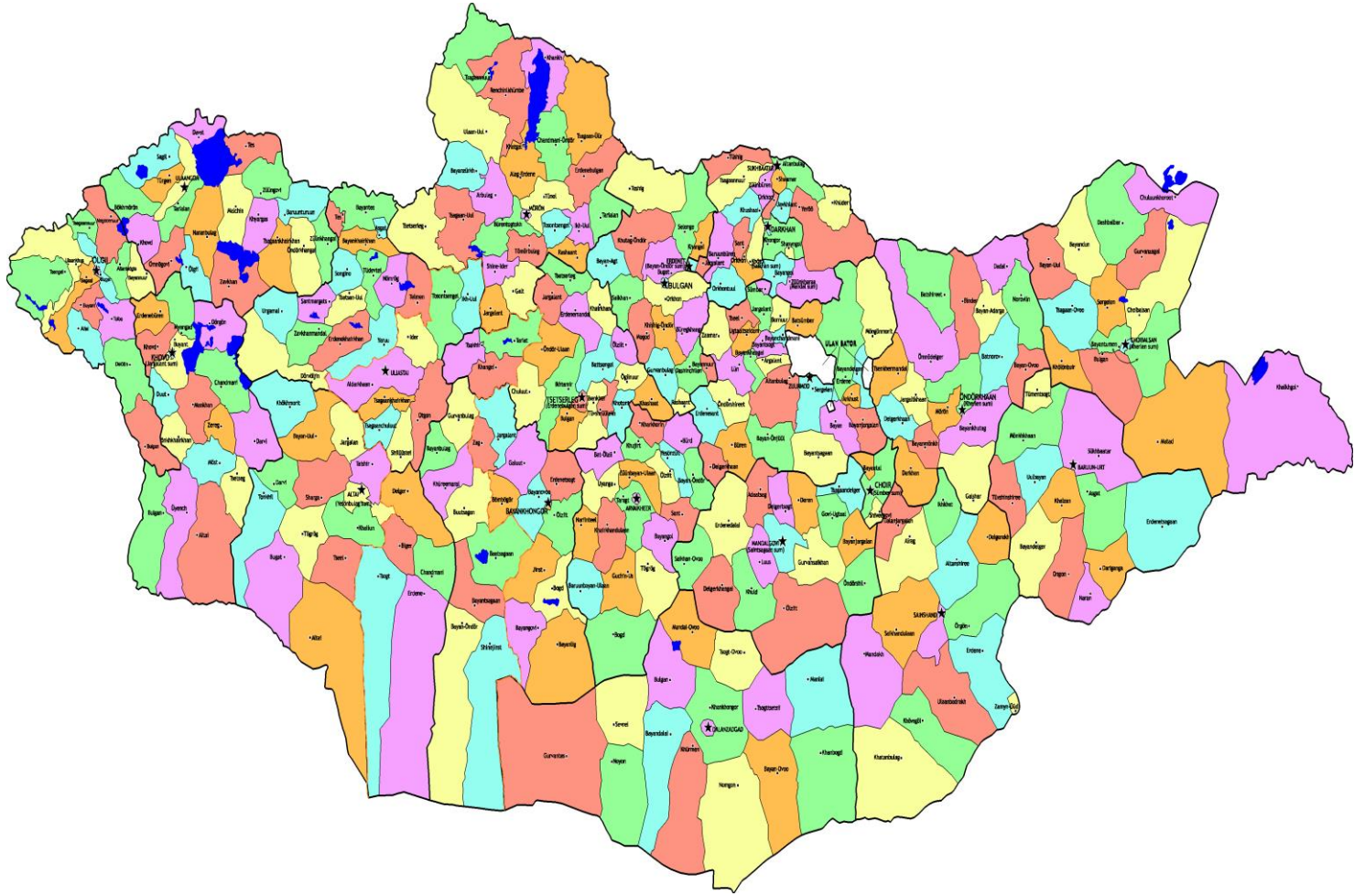

# Biodiversity

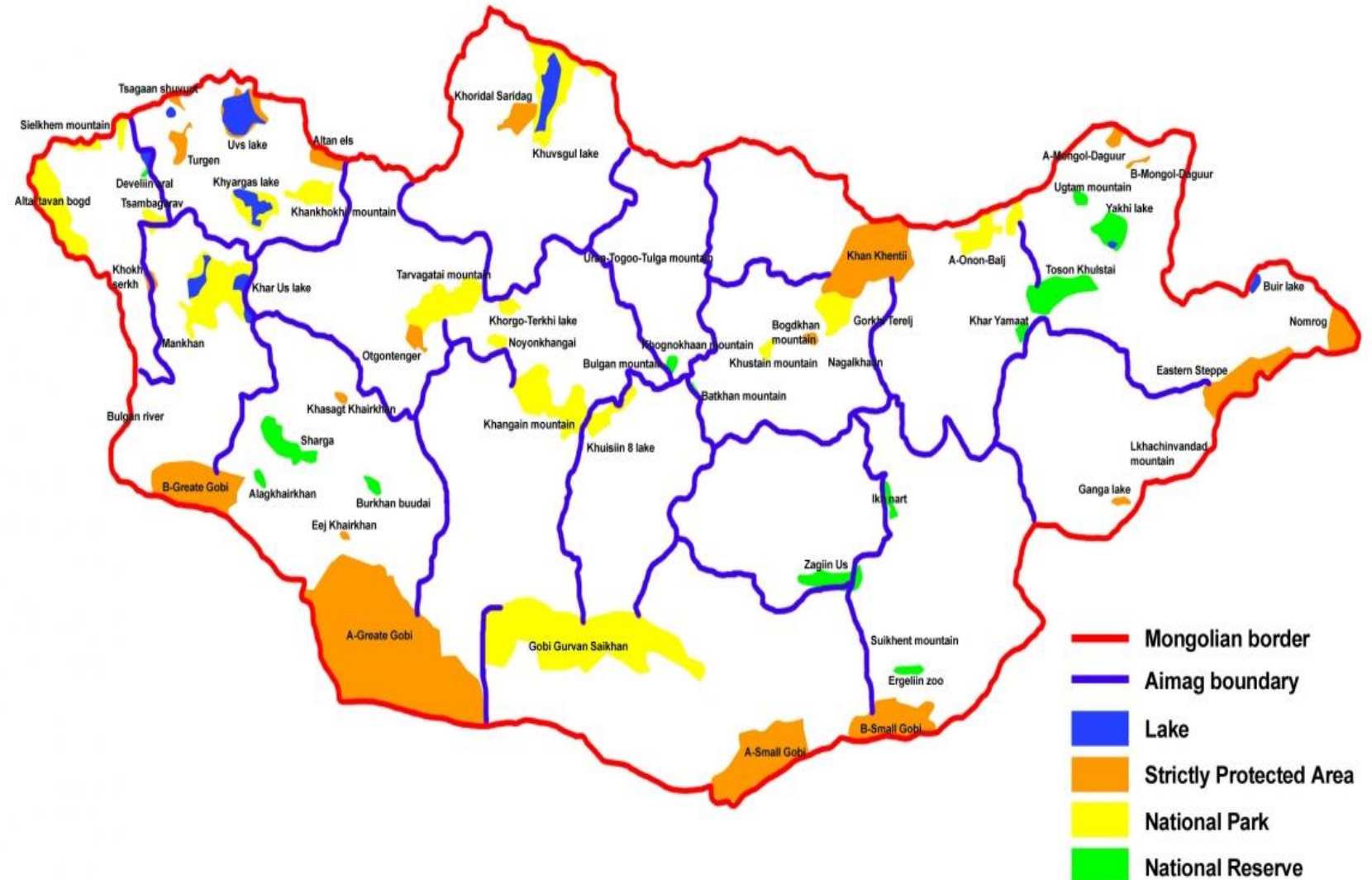
- 5260 plants

96%.

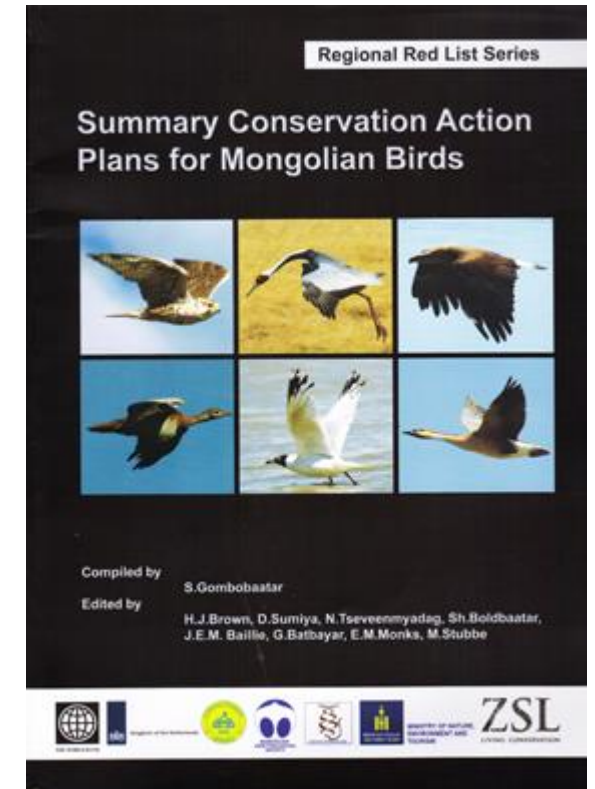
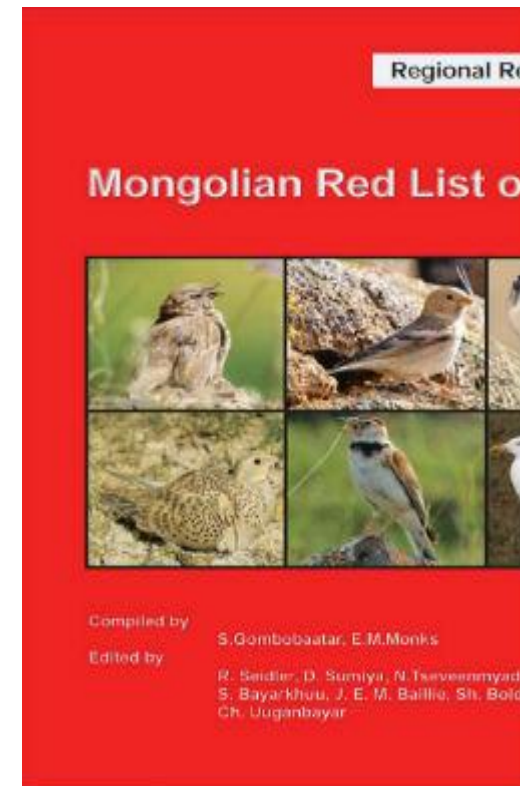
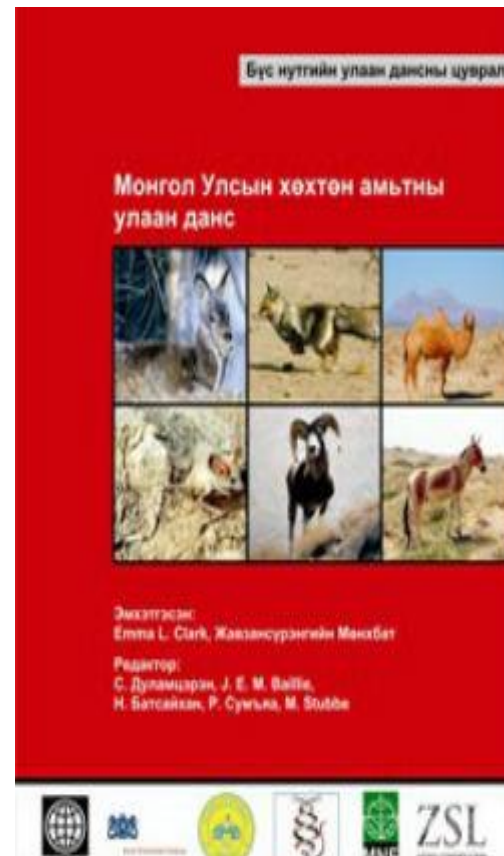

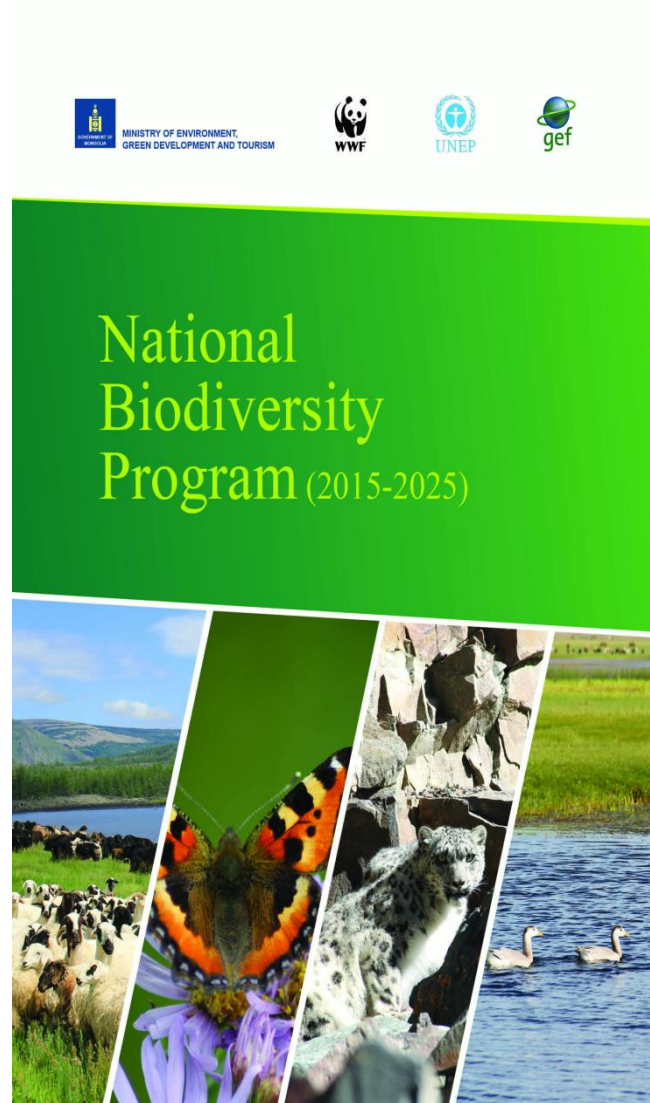

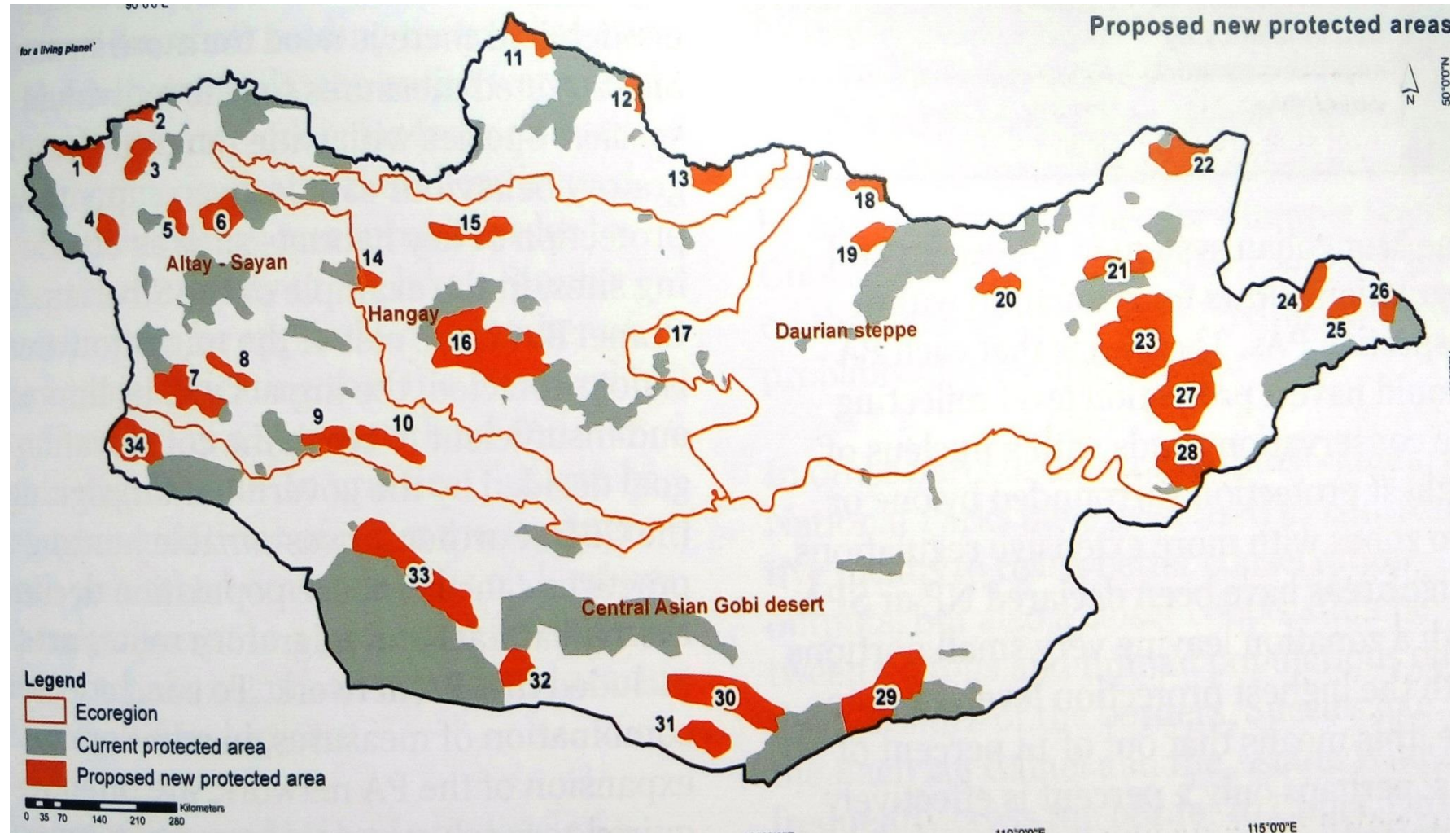

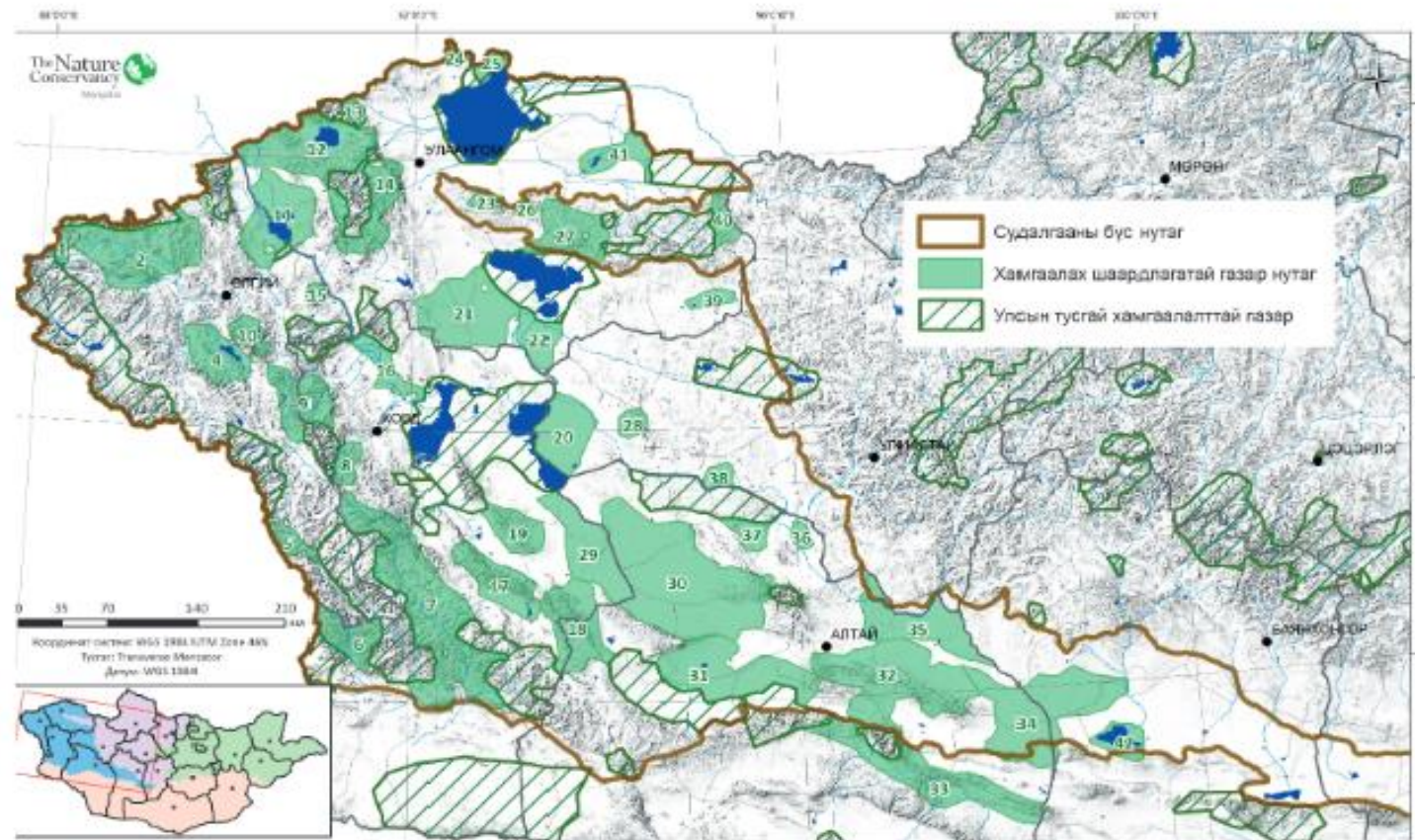
