5. General information on access to Cairo



Cairo is serviced by the Cairo International Airport (CAI/HECA) (about 20 km from the city centre). Taxis are available at the airport at a cost of about US \$15 (265-275 EGP) and it takes about 60-75 minutes depending on traffic. There is an airport shuttle bus available at the arrivals halls, please pay (by destination) at the shuttle bus desk in the arrivals hall and follow instructions on busses.

6. Visa information



Participants from countries listed below require an entry visa for Egypt and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Egyptian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. **Please note that some airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa**.

7. Heath information

Proof of yellow fever vaccination is required only if you are arriving from a country with risk of yellow fever. Please ensure that all of your routine vaccinations are up-to-date.

For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

8. Hotel information

Participants are kindly reminded that they must make their own hotel reservations, and that they should do so as soon as possible.

Participants may wish to avail themselves of a special negotiated rate for the workshop of US \$100 for a single room at the Intercontinental Cairo Semiramis - Regional Workshop on the Clearing House.

9. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA)

The DSA will be paid to participants upon registration for the workshop. Participants should take note that DSA is paid via pre-paid credit card.

The official language of Egypt is Arabic.

11. Weather and time zone information



In March average temperatures in Cairo usually range between a maximum of +24°C in the daytime and a minimum of +11°C at night. Please bring a jacket or sweater for cool evenings. Current weather conditions in the area can be found at: http://worldweather.wmo.int/en/city.html?cityId=248.

The standard time zone in Egypt is EET (Eastern European Time) and is equivalent to GMT/UTC +2 hours.

12. Electricity

The electrical currents in Egypt are 220 Volts, 50 Hertz, and the plugs are as shown in the illustration below.









13. Currency



The currency in Egypt is the Egyptian Pound (EGP). The current exchange rate as at 7 February 2018 is US \$1 = 17.67 EGP and $$\in 1 = 21.67$ EGP (rates are subject to change, source: www.xe.com).
