Note by the Secretariat

1. In paragraph 3 of decisions [16/25](#), [CP-11/5](#) and [NP-5/10](#), the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Nagoya Protocol on Access to Genetic Resources and the Fair and Equitable Sharing of Benefits Arising from their Utilization, respectively, requested the Executive Secretary of the Convention, together with the Bureaux, to continue to explore and make use of, as appropriate, relevant ways and means to facilitate early preparations for meetings, such as the early submission of statements.
2. At a meeting held in Panama City on 31 October and 1 November 2025, the Bureau of the Conference of the Parties agreed to implement pilot modalities for the early submission of statements, on a voluntary and informal basis, for all substantive items of the agenda for the sixth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation, building upon experience related to the modalities gained at the twenty-seventh meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Scientific, Technical and Technological Advice.

3. Consequently, in notification No. [2026-008](#) of 16 January 2026, the Executive Secretary invited Parties and observers to submit written statements on items 3 to 10 of the agenda for the present meeting, in accordance with the modalities contained in annex II to the scenario note,¹ in any of the six official languages of the United Nations, by 15 February 2026 at 11.59 p.m. (Rome time).
4. In response, 134 written statements from Parties and 70 written statements from observers were received by the deadline.
