- Tuvalu is comprise of 9 low lying islands;
- The land area is about 26 sq Km
- ► The total population is about 10,000 people
- Funafuti is the capital of Tuvalu, more than half of the population lived in
- 900,000 km it EEZ
- Given to the fragile environment, Biodiversity FIRST LINE OF DEFENCE to impact of Climate Change

Threat to Biodiversity and Ecosystem services

INVASIVE ALIEN SPECIES (IAS)

- The devastation of the kanava [Cordia subcordata] trees by an invasive moth caterpillar, the kou leafworm [Ethmia nigroapicella]
- 2) Infestations of invasive ants that threaten both land crabs and seabirds hatching [yellow crazy ants] [Anoplolepis gracilipes]
- 3) The spread of an invasive brown seaweed [Sargassum polycystum] in Funafuti lagoon.
