Proposals for the best periodicity of notifications for reviewing and amending the list established in accordance with Article 20, paragraph 2, of the Convention: relevant country lists*

Note by the Secretariat

I. Introduction

1. The present note complements document CBD/SBI/7/3/Add.1, providing proposals for the best periodicity for the issuance of notifications for reviewing and amending the list of developed country Parties and Parties in a position to voluntarily assume the obligations of developed country Parties for resource mobilization, established in accordance with Article 20, paragraph 2, of the Convention (“Convention list” hereafter).

2. In the absence of a clear definition of what constitutes a developed country, document CBD/SBI/7/3/Add.1 summarizes and assesses existing relevant country classification systems, maintained and applied by the United Nations and relevant international organizations, that could be used as proxies, with a view to providing information on whether and to what extent countries are already on the latest Convention list, as adopted in 2006 by the Conference of the Parties at its eighth meeting. For ease of reference, the Convention list adopted in 2006 is reproduced in annex I, while annexes II to VIII contain the relevant lists resulting from these classifications systems. In these lists, Parties to the Convention that are already on the Convention list adopted in 2006 are marked with an asterisk.
