An informative, user-friendly and up-to-date portal that consolidates all biodiversity related efforts within the Cook Islands and that is actively used by our people.

OBJECTIVES

- To consolidate and link together relevant Cook Islands biodiversity information from all partners in a centralised space, with a focus on national and local levels
- To provide a platform for access to biodiversity information to the public to facilitate awareness and communication
- To use this information to support decision making, facilitate scientific, technical and local cooperation.
- to provide a mechanism for exchanging and integrating information on biodiversity between global, regional and national partner organisations.

Comments on roadmap

Work in progress – needs to be confirmed with the team back home.

Cooperation opportunities / Type of support needed

Dependant on CMS chosen but technical support to assist with customization and setting up of the CHM framework in line with the agreed site map, as well as during input of data/information/resources.

Still challenges to be worked out before the CHM framework and server space can be complete. Formation of a technical level coordination mechanism for updating and maintaining content of the CHM e.g. Environment Communications Group will be needed to bring stakeholders into the CHM. Support is needed from the Biodiversity Partners to support the CHM and send their updates to NES for upload.
