67 initiatives directly supporting countries:


- 10 projects (15%) completed;
- 39 projects (58%) ongoing,
- 14 projects (21%) approved (full project documents being elaborated), and
- 4 projects (6%) proposed (project concepts being prepared)








Number of Projects per Region



Duration of the Projects



Core Funding Levels




Core Funding Levels (for National Projects)

Gaps in geographic coverage

- CEE region least covered: 17 of the 23 CEE countries (74%) have no direct ABS project support
- Asia-Pacific region also generally under-covered: 20 of the 56 countries (36%) have no direct project support; especially West Asian countries
- Africa region generally well covered: only 13 of the 56 countries (24%) have no direct ABS project support
- GRULAC region generally well covered: only 8 of the 33 countries (24%) have no direct ABS project support





Overlaps in geographic coverage

A few countries have support from multiple projects

- In Africa, 7 countries have direct support from at least
 3 or more ABS projects; focus in COMIFAC subregion
- In Asia-Pacific, 7 countries have direct support from at least 3 or more ABS projects; focus in ASEAN subregion
- In GRULAC, 7 countries have direct support from at least 3 or more ABS projects

Qn: In the Protocol's formative stage should coverage of support be diversified or focus first on a few countries?





Gaps in thematic coverage

 All the key areas of the strategic framework evenly covered in general; Key area 3 currently least covered

The following may need further attention:

- Valuation of genetic resources and associated TK
- Understanding of business models
- Mobilization of resources for NP implementation
