 - 5.4. Development or strengthening of measures and mechanisms to implement the Protocol's provisions on access to, and the fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from the utilization of, traditional knowledge associated with genetic resources;
 - 5.5. Measures for promoting synergy and mutual supportiveness in the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol and other relevant international agreements and instruments.
6. The way forward:
 - 6.1. Mobilization of resources for the implementation of the Protocol;
 - 6.2. National plans for ratification/accession and implementation of the Nagoya Protocol: roadmaps/action plans towards ratification/accession to the Protocol and the development or amendment of national regulatory frameworks and institutional arrangements and administrative systems to support its implementation;
 - 6.3. Regional and subregional cooperation on the implementation of the Protocol.
7. Closure of the workshop.
