

# Asian Regional Consultations in support of the finalization of the International Regime on Access & Benefit-sharing 4-6 December 2009

#### Borei Angkor Hotel, Siem Reap, Cambodia

#### **General Information**

Welcome to Siem Reap, Cambodi!

#### Registration

The registration for the Conference will be at the Conference Hotel, Borei Angkor Resort and Spa Hotel in Siem Reap between from 8:00 to 9:00 on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December and 8:00 to 8:30 on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2009.

#### **Date and Venue**

The Consultation will take place at the Bokor Ballroom, Borei Angkor Resort and Spa Hotel in the Angkor town located in 2 km away from the Royal Palace. Its address is National Road 6, # 0369, Banteay Chas, Slorkram, Siem Reap, Kingdom of Cambodia.

The Consultation will be conducted in three days from 4-6 December 2009. However, on 4<sup>th</sup> December informal consultation and discussion on substantive issues which are of concern to parties will take place.

#### **Opening Ceremony**

The opening session of the Asia Consultation Meeting will start at 8:30 am on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2009 at the Bokor Ballroom, Borie Angkor Resort and Spa Hotel. The consultation will be opened by Senior Minister of the Ministry of Environment (MoE) of the Royal Government of Cambodia and welcome remarks to be delivered by Siem Reap Governor. CBD Secretariat, UNEP and ACB will likewise give Opening Messages to the Meeting.

#### **Provisional Agenda**

Provisional agenda for this Asian Regional Consultation has been developed by delegate-representatives from Asia and Pacific countries in the *regional consultation meetings for Asia and pacific countries* during WGABS-8 in Montreal. The pending program for informational discussion on 4<sup>th</sup> December is to be decided by delegate-representatives during the meeting (see annex 1).

#### Flight Arrangement

Participants are required to book their own flight to arrive Siem Reap on 3rd December 2009. Upon arrival in Siem Reap, UNEP and ACB will reimburse the air ticket costs - economy class only by the most direct routes with no stop over unless warranted by the airline itinerary and upon submission of original receipt.

#### **Arrival**

All participants are encouraged to book their own flight to arrive Siem Reap on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2009. MoE-Cambodia officers will meet participants at the Arrival Hall of the Siem Reap Airport. Participants shall look for *Asian Regional Consultation* sign after the passenger check point. #### On Arrival Visa

Participants can apply Cambodian visa on arrival at Siem Reap airports for US Dollar 20.00 cash plus US Dollar 5.00 processing fee. A visa form will be issued to you on the airplane or on arrival at Siem Reap Airport. You will also need one or two passport photos to accompany your visa application. Delegates who need assistance on visa matters are required to send their passport details and flight schedules to **Mr. Yin Samray** and **Ms Ken Bopreang** via his and her above email addresses in advance and as soon as possible.

#### Hotel

There are 5 hotels (excluding hotel venue) and two guest houses available for this Asian Regional Consultation, all in walking distance to/from the venue Hotel. All participants are recommended to book their own accommodation in one of those hotels and guest houses listed in annex2. #### **Local Transportation**

The Ministry of Environment of Cambodia will arrange transportation from Siem Reap Airport to Hotel and vice versa for all participants. This journey takes approximately 45 minutes. As soon as possible, please let us know, prior to your arrival, your flight number, date and time of arrival in Siem Reap for coordination. You will be met by one of the MoE officers at the airport holding signage for the Asia Consultation Meeting.

Participants are requested to arrange dinner on their own on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2009. Lunch arrangements will be made for all participants at the venue hotel.

#### **Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA)**

UNEP/ACB will provide one delegate from Asia countries with a Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) for the period of their participation in the consultation. The DSA with the UN Rate is based on the duration of participant stay according to delegate's official date of arrival in and departure from Siem Reap. An additional of one full DSA will also be provided to funded participants to cover terminal expenses, pocket allowance, costs of visa and airport transfers in their country of origin.

Please be informed that the DSA will be distributed during the registration period on 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> December 2009 at the meeting venue.

#### **Currency Exchange**

The unit of currency is the *Real*. However, US dollar is acceptable for any expenditure. Exchange of certain currencies may be limited, therefore, it is recommended to bring US dollars. Participants can exchange money at market, bank or at the airport. Since US dollar is accepted in the market, participants are not recommended to exchange large amount. Exchange rate at the hotel may be low. The currency exchange rate is approximately US\$1=Real 4100. ATMs are available in the city center and some petroleum stations. Major credit cards such as VISA and MasterCard are accepted at most hotels, some shops and restaurants.

#### Official Language

The official Language in Cambodia is Khmer, but English is spoken and understood in hotels, shops and restaurants. The Asia Consultation Meeting will be conducted in English.

#### **Time**

Cambodia Time is 7 hours ahead of GMT (GMT+07:00).

#### **Electricity**

220 volts, 50Hz; both round and thin two-pin (in some places can use square three-pin) plugs are in use. Participants are advised to check the voltage before using appliances. Some participants may need to bring converters or adapters.

#### Weather and clothing

We will recommend participants to bring light clothes. Siem Reap enjoys a warm and sunny climate. The average day temperature in Cambodia this time of the year is around 20-30 degrees Celsius, but there is windy in some how.

#### Sightseeing programme

The Ministry of Environment of the Royal Government of Cambodia will organize sightseeing programs at Angkor temples on afternoon of 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> December, depending on the progress of the meeting. Participants who are accompanied by their family members or friends and would like to join the trip are welcome but they are required to inform and send the name(s) to Cambodian organizer in advance, but no later than three day before departure date to Siem Reap, otherwise they will charge for entry free to visit Angkor Temples at cost USD20/day per person.

#### **Travel Agency**

All most of hotels and guest house in Siem Reap have good connection with Travel Agency, therefore, participants can confirm their flights and booking trip for visit Angkor Wat at the hotel.
