

There are two official languages in Canada: English and French. French is the official language of Quebec; however English is widely spoken in Montreal.

In November, temperatures in Montreal usually range between a maximum of $+5^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and a minimum of -5° C at night. The general weather conditions are cold, rainy with a possibility of light snow at this time of the year. You are advised to bring warm clothing. The standard time zone will be GMT -5 hours. The currency in Canada is the Canadian Dollar (CAD \$). The current exchange rate is US 1 = CAD 1.07 and (Euro) 1 = CAD 1.49.
