

1. Opening and registration

The "Friends of the CBD" workshop on mechanisms to support review of implementation of the Convention will be held in Bogis-Bossey, Switzerland from Monday, 21 March to Wednesday, 23 March 2016.

General information on access to Bogis-Bossey 5.



Bogis-Bossey is located 18km from Geneva and can be accessed from the Geneva Cointrin International Airport by train and/or taxi. Please note that a transportation ticket, valid for 80 minutes, is available free of charge to passengers at the international arrivals hall of the airport.

Transportation by train:

The Château de Bossey can be reached by train from the Geneva Airport or from the main train stations in Geneva and Lausanne through the Coppet and Nyon stations. Once you arrive at the Coppet or Nyon station, take a taxi to the Château de Bossey.

Taxi from Nyon station: Taxis are available at the train station.

• Taxi from Coppet station: Book the taxi in advance. (Taxi AAB: 079 362 11 11).

For participants arriving on Sunday, 20 March 2016, please note that the self-service restaurant at the venue is only open between 18:00 and 20:00.

6. Visa information



Participants requiring a Schengen visa for Switzerland are strongly advised to contact the nearest Swiss diplomatic representation **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

Information on visa procedures, including a list of relevant Swiss diplomatic representations is provided below:

- The visa applications must be submitted to the Swiss Embassy/Consulate covering your place of residence;
- The visa application must be accompanied by the travel document, as well as further documents, if so required, which clearly indicate the purpose and circumstances of the intended stay or the intended transit;

8. Payment of the daily subsistence allowances (DSA)

The relevant portion of the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) will be paid to sponsored participants on the first day of the workshop. Sponsored participants are asked to submit their boarding pass and present their passports which will be photocopied and returned to them.

The official languages are: French, German, Italian and Romansh. English and/or French is spoken in hotels and restaurants.

10. Weather and time zone information

The standard time in Bogis-Bossey is GMT/UTC +1 hour.

The electrical currents are 220 Volts, 50 Hertz. The type of sockets used is illustrated below:

The currency in Switzerland is the Swiss Franc (CHF). The current exchange rate as at 29 February 2016 is US \$1 = CHF \$0.99 and \$0 = CHF \$1.08 (source: www.xe.com, rates are subject to change).
