

### 5. General information on access to Lima, Peru



Lima is serviced by the Jorge Chavez International Airport (13 km from San Isidro, Lima). An agreement has been reached with Taxi Green for the transfer of participants to their Hotel at a cost of \$21-32 per trip, per taxi, depending on the number of passengers. Please proceed to the Taxi Green counter at the arrivals hall before leaving the airport. Participants are strongly advised to make use of this service. Participants must pay the taxi service directly.

#### 6. Visa information



Participants from countries listed in **annex A** below require an entry visa for Peru and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Peruvian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

#### 7. Health information

The International travel, health and vaccination requirements for travel to Peru can be obtained from the World Health Organization (WHO) web site: http://apps.who.int/tools/geoserver/www/ith/index.html.

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is not required for travellers to Lima.

There is a risk of Malaria that exists throughout the year in rural areas at altitudes below 2000 metres. The 23 highest-risk districts are concentrated in the regions of Ayacucho, Junín, Loreto, Madre de Dios, Piura, San Martin and Tumbes.

For more information, please consult a medical professional with regard to the vaccination requirements for your travel.

#### 8. Hotel information

Participants are requested to make their own hotel reservations. In December, temperatures in Lima usually range between a maximum of  $+22^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and a minimum of  $+16^{\circ}$ C at night. The currency in Peru is the Peruvian Nuevo Sol. The current exchange rate as at 22 November 2011 is US \$1 = PEN 2.70 and  $$\in 1 = PEN 3.65$ . It is recommended to use the exchange office at the airport.
