MONITORING AND REPORTING (ARTICLE 33)

Note by the Executive Secretary

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Article 33 of the Protocol requires each Party to report, at intervals to be determined by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety (COP-MOP), on measures that it has taken to implement the Protocol. In this regard, at its first meeting, in its decision BS-I/9, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol requested Parties to submit their reports every four years and twelve months prior to the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol that would consider the reports. To date, the Parties to the Protocol have, on the following three occasions, been requested to submit their reports: (a) an interim national report by September 2005; (b) a first national report by September 2007 and (c) a second national report by September 2011.

2. At its fifth meeting, the COP-MOP, in its decision BS-V/14, paragraph 8(a), requested the Executive Secretary to consider adjusting the reporting format of the third and subsequent national reports, and make the format available to the appropriate meeting of the Parties to the Protocol, with a view to relating the national reports to the strategic priorities of the Protocol by limiting subsequent reporting to: (a) questions that require regular updating; and (b) questions relating to priority areas applicable to the reporting period as indicated in the Strategic Plan and the programme of work and as determined by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol.

3. At its sixth meeting, the COP-MOP, in its decision BS-VI/14, requested the Executive Secretary to update the reporting format, taking into account the experience gained from analysing the second national reports, the recommendations of the Compliance Committee and the feedback received from Parties. In the same decision, the Executive Secretary was also requested to submit the revised format, adjusted in accordance with paragraph 8(a) of decision BS V/14, to the seventh meeting of the Parties to the Protocol for its consideration.

4. Furthermore, the COP-MOP, in its decision BS-VI/15, requested the Executive Secretary to undertake a dedicated survey to gather information corresponding to indicators in the Strategic Plan for the Protocol that could not be obtained from the second national reports or through other existing mechanisms, review the information gathered through the survey and make the results available to the Parties before their seventh meeting.”¹

5. A revised draft format has therefore been developed by the Secretariat within the context of decisions BS-V/14, BS-VI/14 and BS-VI/15, taking into account the comments on the improvement of the reporting format received from Parties during the second national report process and the survey to gather information corresponding to indicators in the Strategic Plan as well as the recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

6. The format is intended to gather relevant data on the implementation, operation and effectiveness of national biosafety systems to facilitate both the process of the third assessment and review of effectiveness of the Protocol as well as the measurement of progress at the mid-term evaluation of the Strategic Plan.

7. In the development of the format for the third national report, the following general principles have been applied:

(a) The retention of all relevant questions from the second national report format that require regular updating (such as questions that refer to information and/or measurable indicators that may change between reporting intervals), as requested in decision BS-V/14, paragraph 8(a)(i). In view of the current low number of Parties that have a domestic regulatory framework “fully in place” (34%, as reported in the second national reports), all questions to which responses measure progress in implementation of the provisions of the Cartagena Protocol have been considered among those that require updating;

(b) The introduction of all questions from the “survey to gather information corresponding to indicators in the Strategic Plan” (UNEP/CBD/BS/COP-MOP/7/INF/10) to ensure monitoring of progress in implementation through the use of the indicators as established in the Strategic Plan, and requested in decision BS-V/14, paragraph 8(a)(ii);

(c) The deletion of all questions from the second national report format for which responses are available to the Secretariat through the Biosafety Clearing-House (for example: “Has your country designated one national focal point for the Cartagena Protocol to be responsible for liaison with the Secretariat?”);

(d) The merging of all questions that were similar, or addressed the same issues, in both the second national report format and in the dedicated “survey to gather information corresponding to indicators in the Strategic Plan”.

8. The draft format for the third national report as contained in the annex is proposed for the consideration of the COP-MOP as a necessary tool for assisting Parties in reviewing the extent of their successful implementation of the provisions of the Protocol. The responses to the questionnaire will assist the COP-MOP in assessing the overall status of implementation of the Protocol, including measuring the progress in its review of the Strategic Plan of the Protocol.

9. The COP-MOP may wish to adopt the proposed format for the third national report with a view to gathering the relevant information to facilitate both the mid-term review of the implementation of the Strategic Plan for the Cartagena Protocol and the third assessment and review of the Protocol by Parties at their eighth meeting.

10. The proposed draft format includes references to the origin of the questions (either from second national report format, or from the dedicated survey on the indicators or directly included in the draft third national report format) to aid in understanding the rationale and justification for their inclusion in the current format. While these references are intended to aid in understanding the rationale behind each of the questions, it is proposed that the Secretariat remove these references in the reporting format adopted by COP-MOP 7.

II. ELEMENTS FOR A DRAFT DECISION

11. The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety may wish to consider the information requested under the third national reporting format and their intended role of facilitating the conduct of both the mid-term review of the implementation of the Strategic Plan for the Cartagena Protocol as well as the third assessment and review of the Protocol by:

(a) Adopting the reporting format annexed hereto and requesting Parties to use it for the third national report on the implementation of the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety;

(b) Recommending that Parties prepare their reports through a consultative process involving all relevant national stakeholders, as appropriate;

(c) Encouraging Parties to respond to all questions in the reporting format in order to facilitate the monitoring of progress towards the implementation of the objectives identified in the Strategic Plan and also contribute to the third assessment and review of the Cartagena Protocol;

(d) Requesting Parties to submit to the Secretariat their third national report on the implementation of the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety:

(i) Twelve months prior to the eighth meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol, which will consider the report;

(ii) In an official language of the United Nations;

(iii) In both hard copy and electronic format.

12. Recognizing the limitations that some Parties may face in fulfilling their national reporting obligation under the Protocol and considering the experience gained by the contribution of the financial support of the Global Environment Facility during the second national report process, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety may wish to urge the Global Environment Facility to make financial resources available with a view to enabling such eligible Parties to prepare their national reports.

**FORMAT FOR THE THIRD NATIONAL REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
CARTAGENA PROTOCOL ON BIOSAFETY**

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GUIDELINES FOR USE OF THE REPORTING FORMAT

The following reporting format is prepared for the collection of data on implementation for the third national report as required under Article 33 of the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety. It consists of a series of questions based on those requirements of the Protocol as well as questions that relate to indicators of the Strategic Plan.

The format has been developed within the context of decision of decisions BS-V/14, BS-VI/14 and BS-VI/15, taking into account the comments on the improvement of the reporting format received from Parties during the second national report exercise and the survey to gather information corresponding to indicators in the Strategic Plan as well as the recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

The general principles that have been applied in the development of the third National Report are as follows; *a) the retention of all questions from the second national report format that require regular updating (i.e. refer to information and/or measurable indicators that may change between reporting times) as requested in decision BS-V/14, paragraph 8(a), point (i); b) the introduction of all questions from the survey on the indicators; c) the deletion of all questions from the second national report format whose answer are already available to the Secretariat through the Biosafety Clearing-House; and d) the merging of all questions that were similar, or addressed the same issues, in both the second national report format and in the dedicated survey on the indicators.*

Responses to these questions will help Parties review the extent to which they are successfully implementing the provisions of the Protocol. The responses will also assist the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Protocol (COP-MOP) in assessing the overall status of the implementation of the Protocol, including measuring the progress in its review of the Strategic Plan of the Protocol.

Questions with background highlighted in grey may not strictly be based on the provisions of the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety, the Strategic Plan indicators or the decisions of the Parties to the Protocol and are included, as non-mandatory, to help in the assessment and review of the Protocol in the context of Article 35.

The deadline for the submission of the third national report is no less than 12 months prior to the eight meeting of the COP-MOP. The report is intended to cover activities undertaken between the presentation of the second national report (or the entry into force of the Protocol for reporting Parties that ratified or acceded to the Protocol after 11 September 2007) and the date of reporting for the third national report.

The wording of questions follows the wording of the relevant articles of the Protocol as closely as possible. The use of terms in the questions follows the meanings accorded to them under Article 3 of the Protocol.

All questions listed in the report format contribute to measuring progress against the baseline adopted by decision BS-VI/15, para 2.

The format tries to minimize the reporting burden on Parties, while eliciting the important information regarding the implementation of the provisions of the Protocol. Most of the questions posed require only a tick in one or more boxes. Text fields are provided to allow the provision of further details on the implementation of the various articles. Although there is no set limit on the length of text, in order to assist with the review and synthesis of the information in the reports, respondents are encouraged to ensure that answers are as relevant and as succinct as possible.

The Executive Secretary welcomes any comments on the adequacy of the questions, difficulties in completing the questions, and any further recommendations on how these reporting guidelines could be improved. Space is provided for such comments at the end of the report.

It is recommended that Parties involve all relevant stakeholders in the preparation of the report in order to ensure a participatory and transparent approach to its development and the accuracy of the information requested.
