- Pakistan currently has no National Clearing-House Mechanism (CHM) developed under CBD.
- Plan to develop National CHM, together with the Biodiversity Information System (BIS).

PRIORITIES IN THE NATIONAL BIODIVERSITY STRATEGY AND ACTION PLAN

- NBSAP
- Preparation of the new NBSAP process going on with national targets aligned to Strategic Goals 2011-2020 and Aichi Biodiversity Targets

LESSONS LEARNED NBSAPS

- Required effective monitoring system
- Information sharing mechanisms need to be developed
- Importance of political support for implementation of NBSAP

THE MAIN THEMATIC AREAS TO BE INCLUDED IN PAKISTAN CHM

- Forest ecosystems (Evergreen, Semievergreen, Moist deciduous)
- Agricultural biodiversity and agroecological zones
- Marine and coastal ecosystem
- Inland wetland biodiversity etc

- Capacity Building
- Technical support to develop the Biodiversity CHM
- Financial assistance
- Information sharing
