# Belgian Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan

## Background:

**The 3 Regions: Flanders, Walloon Region and Brussels Capital are responsible for their biodiversity.**



**Federal level only mandate for biodiversity in North Sea, Military domains and along railroads**

# **Belgian Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan**

**The 3 Regions have developed their strategies since 2000.**

**Political support for national strategy only since 2005**

**National strategy should strengthen regional strategies but not touch regional competences.**



# **Belgian Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan**

**Adoption of National Strategy 2006-2012 in  
October 2006**

**Range of priority objectives to anticipate, prevent  
and reduce the causes of biodiversity loss in  
Belgium**

**15 objectives with activities**

**XLS file updated by the National focal point for the Convention on yearly basis.**



# Follow up of BE BSAP

## Involvement of the CHM since 2009

1. Development of structure
2. Adding information from XLS file of 2008
3. Updating in principal by nfp and regional focal points (users of the site)
4. Update based on 4th national report not yet done .....
