Comments on roadmap

In order to achieve the mentioned objectives, the national focal point will have to sell the idea of the CHM to the minister responsible for this department. It will involve interaction and collaboration between different stakeholders.

Specific organizations that information would be required from include:

- Ministry of Agriculture that deals with Forestry
- Ministry of Fisheries that is responsible for Marine Biodiversity
- St. Kitts National Trust
- St. Kitts Heritage Society

Cooperation opportunities / Type of support needed

To effectively implement the CHM, there will have to be numerous support from all parties involved in the convention on biodiversity. Different agencies host information within their departments so collaboration will be imperative.

There must be:

- ▶ Support and assistance from the stakeholders (MOA, MOF, SCNT, SKHS)
- ▶ Technical support from the IT Department to help with the site development
- ▶ Collaboration from target groups, government agencies and NGOs to make information available and accessible
- ▶ Financial support where needed to help maintain the site which will include servers and hosting space

Once there is support and collaboration from the different agencies and NGOs it would lead to a simple process to retrieving information to populate the CHM website
