

Total:	875,339





Progress Update	CHM NFP, SCBD, Partner	Description of some progress at a given time. Format similar to a blog post.





Content type	Description
<text box=""></text>	Short text
<text line=""></text>	Single line of text
<text area=""></text>	Multi-line text description
<date></date>	Date
<number></number>	Numeric value
<currency amount=""></currency>	Amount expressed in a particular currency (e.g. USD)
<yes no=""></yes>	Yes/No flag or checkbox
<email></email>	Valid email address
<file(s)></file(s)>	Uploaded file(s), including documents, images or other attachments
<url(s)></url(s)>	Insertion of one or more links (URLs)
<selection(s)></selection(s)>	Single or multiple selection from a controlled vocabulary
<reference(s)></reference(s)>	Single or multiple references to other submitted records
<option></option>	Single option selection through radio buttons (typically used in questionnaires)
