Comments on national situation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The FSM is a five government entity (1 federal government, 4 State governments), where biodiversity jurisdiction falls under the State governments.</li> <li>The Department of Resources and Development (R&amp;D) facilitates CBD obligations at the country level as the focal point. Through the National Implementation Support Partnership (NISP) agreement amongst the states and stakeholders.</li> <li>The FSM NBSAP is a collection of four NBSAPs from the states that culminate into the National NBSAP.</li> <li>CHM is not effectively executed and lacking content from the multiple stakeholders.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create a national CHM and maintain on going content flow. Through the activities of updating the NISP and NBSAP, empower the focal points at the National and State levels with the usage and dissemination of information through the CHM.</li> </ul>

The National Focal point through the National Implementation Support Partnership (NISP) agreement needs to officially adopt and agree to a platform to stage the national CHM on. In addition it needs to identify one key person to maintain the CHM on a continuous basis. The Bioland Tool serves as a great example of a platform the National focal point could adopt.
