### **CONSERVATION OF NATURE**

• There are four main acts and their sub-law-documents in Bulgaria that regulate bio-diversity conservation and they are as follows:, Protected Areas Act, Biological Diversity Act, Medicinal Plants Act and Environmental Protection Act.

The Protected Areas Act introduces a modern protected areas classification in compliance with the International norms.

There are **6 categories** of protected areas, which are particularly, as follows:

- Reserve strictly protected area, no human activity allowed
- National park highly protected, limited human activity allowed
- Natural monument protection of natural features, activity allowed
- Managed reserve activities for conservation purpose allowed
- Nature park active interaction of humans and nature in sustainable way
- Protected site habitat protection and sustainable use of natural products

#### **Protected Areas**

Bulgaria's protected areas system includes 3 national parks /Rila National Park, Pirin National Park and Central Balkan National Park/, 55 reserves, 35 managed reserves, 10 nature parks, 419 protected sites and 346 natural monuments.




#### **Protected Areas in hectares/years**








