





1. Get a CBD user account



2. Get access to the system

- CBD NFP = User administrators → Authority to assign roles to other national users.
- Contact your CBD NFP to get access to the official system
- National Publishing Authority (NPA)
 - → Can <u>publish</u> national reporting records (National Reports, Progress on Targetts,)
- National Authorized User (NRA)
 - → Can <u>draft</u> national reporting records (National Reports, Progress on Targetts,)
 - → Can <u>submit</u> them to the NPA ffor publishing


