The meeting will start at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, 22 March 2012, and registration will take place at the venue of the meeting from 8:30 a.m. the same day.

The Nagoya International Center is located above "Kokusai Center Subway Station" on the Sakura-dori Subway Line. This station is linked to the Nagoya International Center through the basement level. At the ticket gate, exit to the right and take the left corridor towards exit 2.

The Nagoya International Center is just a 7 minute walk from Nagoya Station. In this case, you may use the underground passage called "Unimall" which links the Nagoya Station and the Kokusai Center Station.

The nearest international airport servicing Nagoya is "Centrair", the Central Japan International Airport (<a href="http://www.centrair.jp/en/">http://www.centrair.jp/en/</a>) which is located about 45 km from Nagoya City. ## 6. Visa information



Holders of ordinary passports from countries <u>NOT LISTED</u> in (Annex B) require an entry visa to Japan, and it is recommended to contact the Consular Section of the Embassy or the Consulate General of Japan nearest you in advance in order to obtain information about the visa application procedure and the necessary documents required for the visa application.

Diplomatic/Official passport or Laissez-passer holders are advised to contact the Consular Section of the **Embassy** or the Consulate General of Japan http://www.mofa.go.jp/about/emb cons/over/index.html in advance in order to obtain information about the necessity of an entry visa to Japan, the visa application procedure and the necessary documents for the visa application.

It should be noted that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa; visas cannot be obtained upon arrival in Japan.




