- Develop a short-term action plan to enhance and support CB

Decision XII/2 B, paragraph 9 and 19

- Enhance TSC and technology transfer to support SPfB &NBSAPs
- Link needs of Parties with available support for TSC
- Continue developing the CHM and develop a web strategy











Agenda Item 12: Background

SBI-1 in in recommendation 1/5:

- Took note of the draft short-term action plan and requested the Secretariat to streamline and focus it, with particular focus on:
 - Priority capacity-building needs submitted by Parties,
 - Needs identified by Parties in their NBSAPs, and
 - Activities linked to the facilitation of collaboration and coordination among Governments and organizations so as to avoid duplication
- Also took note of the draft web strategy for the Convention and its Protocols and requested the Secretariat to align it with the communication strategy

The revision of the short-term Action Plan is expected to:

- Streamline activities to remove duplications;
- Take into account activities already funded
- Take into account findings of the evaluation of the effectiveness and analysis of gaps in capacity building activities
- Take into account the Aichi Targets with less progress;
- Identify activities based on inputs from Parties during the peerreview of the draft Action Plan;
- Identify activities likely to be the most effective;
- Identify activities to be facilitated by the Secretariat and by others;

Draft Decision (based on SBI recommendation 1/5)

- [Endorse][Adopt][Take note] of the short-term action plan (2017-2020) on capacity-building
- Invite Parties, other Governments and relevant organizations to:
 - Take measures to enhance the implementation of Article 12
 - Contribute to TSC by, inter alia, providing information on priority needs, offering examples of effective practices/bright spots for replication, linking the needs of Parties with available support for TSC through CHM, ABS-CHM and NRs
 - Encourage and support relevant institutions and IPLCs to contribute to TSC











- Invites Parties, other Governments and relevant organizations to:
 - Support the establishment and maintenance of programmes for scientific and technical education and training to address specific needs of developing countries
 - Further develop effective national CHMs
 - Provide further guidance on measures for improving its implementation
- Extend the mandate of the CHM-IAC; to review it again at COP-15













Requests the Secretariat to

- Promote a more integrated and coordinated approach to CB and TSC through multiple partnerships
- Strengthen coherent action on capacity-building and through an integrated support platform of the clearing-houses
- Take a more strategic approach in establishing partnerships with organizations and entities with comparative advantages
- Catalyze and facilitate implementation of the short-term action plan and report on progress to SBI
- Monitor and evaluate the outcomes and effectiveness of ongoing CB activities to better target and improve future activities











Requests the Secretariat to

- Commission an independent evaluation of the impacts, outcomes and effectiveness of the action plan
- Further develop the CHM and implement the web strategy

At the present meeting participants are invited to:

- Critically review and prioritize the activities in the short-term action plan for capacity-building (if possible reduce the 120+ activities by more than 50%)
- Provide comments on the draft BBI Action Plan 2017-2020
