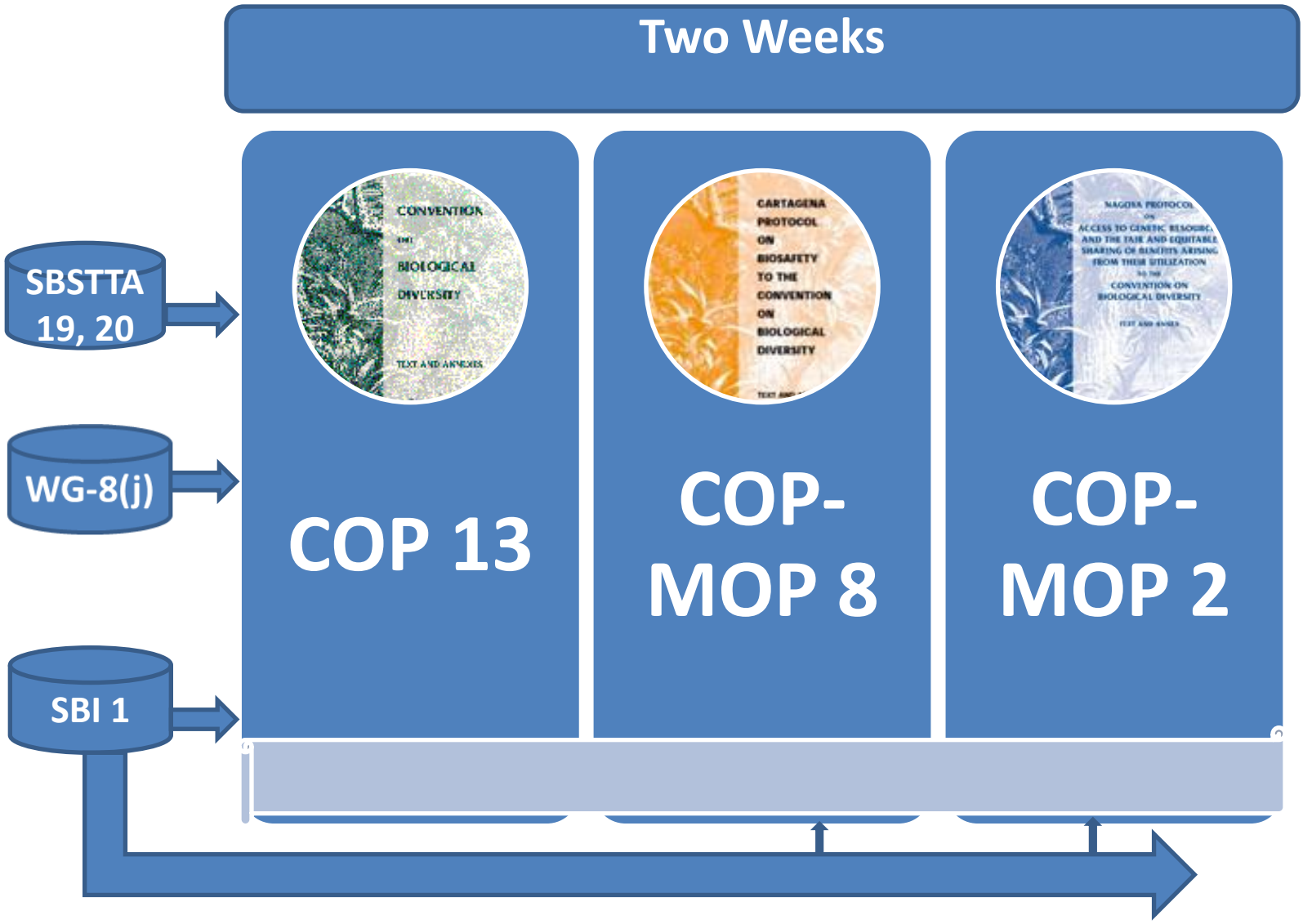

Note by the Executive Secretary

1. BASIC FEATURES OF THE PLAN

It is the refinement of the plan considered by COP 12

It provides a framework for an organization of work

It describes the flow of events/sessions and the forums where these sessions are intended to take place

It identifies items for consideration in proximity and items for joint consideration

It highlights some of the technical arrangements


IMPORTANT PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS

- **Avoiding/reducing potential confusion on the allocation of work between working groups**
- **Reducing constraints for small delegations**
- **Availability of appropriate staff to service each session/agenda item**

- **One working group considers most of the items under the protocols while the other takes up COP items**
- **Related agenda items are grouped for consideration in proximity or jointly**
