6. Visa information



Participants from countries listed in **annex A** below require an entry visa for Canada and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Canadian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. It should be noted that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa.

The currency in Canada is the Canadian Dollar (CAD \$). The current exchange rate as at 17 March 2009 is US \$1 = CAD \$1.27 and (Euro) $$\in 1 = CAD 1.65 .
