# Actions to achieve Aichi Targets 5, 11, 15

#### Target 5

Rate of loss of all natural habitats, including forests, is at least halved and where feasible brought close to zero, and degradation and fragmentation is significantly reduced




#### Target 11

At least 17% of terrestrial and inland water and 10% of coastal and marine areas ... are conserved through effectively and equitably managed ... systems of protected areas



#### **SPAW Protocol**

Take necessary measures to protect, preserve and manage in a sustainable way ... areas that require protection to safeguard their special value and threatened or endangered species of flora and fauna



## Caribbean Challenge Initiative

 To effectively conserve and manage at least 20% of the marine and coastal environment by 2020 [including support by fully functioning sustainable finance mechanisms]

The Caribbean Challenge Initiative



#### Activities and actions in the region

- GEF funding for financially sustainable national protected areas systems
- Designating protected areas and establishing management plans
- Establishment and capitalization of the Caribbean Biodiversity Fund and national trust funds



#### Target 15

Enhance ecosystem resilience and the contribution of biodiversity to carbon stocks through conservation and restoration, including restoration of at least 15% of degraded ecosystems, thereby contributing to climate change mitigation and adaptation...




### **CARICOM Agricultural Policy**

 Safeguard[] the aquatic environment from pollutants and hazardous waste, in order to sustain fisheries production and protect fishing communities from the impact of global warming, climate change, and natural disasters.

# Implementation Plan for the CARICOM Regional Climate Change Framework

- Use forests to support sustainable development while reducing GHG emissions
- Manage the effects of climate change on coastal and marine areas/resources



#### Activities and actions in the region

- Mangrove restoration
- Negotiations with international partners to mobilize resources for protection of forests
- Low carbon development strategies
- Mapping of coastal ecosystems, incl. seagrass beds and mangroves to document location, state of health
