

Day 2 – Recap points

- As countries transition their economies to meet development needs, forest exploitation will increase
- Employing REDD+ actions can mitigate the loss of forest cover, but creating synergistic actions for REDD+ and the relevant Aichi Biodiversity Targets can move countries towards sustainable development
- Spatial mapping is one common planning tool for working towards both REDD+ and NBSAP actions
- Spatial mapping can incorporate many layers of data or many datasets and these should be chosen based on the specific requirements of the area in analysis
- Much spatial mapping data can be found online
- Countries need to develop expertise in how to engage the variety of spatial planning data to meet their needs
- The regional organization OSFAC provides spatial data to countries as well as training
