

CBD COP 10 Decision X/26

Objective:

"...enable COP to make an assessment ...and determine the amount of resources needed..." in GEF-6 [first time ever exercise!]

Scope:

"...assessing total funding needs required to meet agreed full incremental costs of measures..."



Methodology:

- a)CBD Art 20, Art 21 and Strategic Plan 2011-2020
- b)COP guidance to the GEF
- c)CBD obligations and COP decisions
- d)National reports to COPs
- e)GEF Council rules/guidelines reg. eligibility
- f)NBSAPs
- g)GEF report on approved and turned down projects
- h)Experience in needs assessments of others
- i)limitations and successes of GEF projects
- j)Synergies with other GEF-funded Conventions



Implementation Process:

- ✓ CBD Sec to contract a team of five experts
 after consultation of Parties and nomination:
 - 2 developing countries: Brazil, India
 - 2 developed countries: France, Sweden
 - 1 int. NGO: GEF NGO Network

Terms of Reference:

"the expert team should undertake interviews, surveys, quantitative and qualitative analyses, and consultation"



Implementation Process:

- design a questionnaire and circulate it to all Parties
- regional and subregional consultation: NBSAPs
- review of draft by the GEF Sec and CBD Sec
- deliver to WGRI-4 for consideration
- WGRI-4 to make recommendations for COP-11



Implementation Process: Where are we?

- √ three expert group meetings: Montreal, Tokyo, Quito
- ✓ circulated questionnaire to Parties with little response
- ✓ undertaken analysis of funding needs

Structure of the zero draft report

- √ target-by-target approach
- √ reference to COP decisions and COP GEF guidance
- ✓ identified activities to achieve the target in GEF-6 (7)
- ✓ estimated cost in various options and scenarios
- ✓ reference to GEF eligibility / incremental reasoning



Some points to note regarding preliminary results

- Strategic Plan 2011-2020 and the Aichi Biodiversity
 Targets is an ambitious framework and new to GEF
- shift from primarily protected areas to a broader "mainstreaming" approach addressing drivers
- shift from a an approach focussed on individual projects to a programme based approach (NBSAP)
- may require changes in the technical capacity and policy of the GEF and its implementing agencies
- GEF to leverage / mobilize funds from other sources
- need of more domestic funds and innovative sources
