Variety of habitats



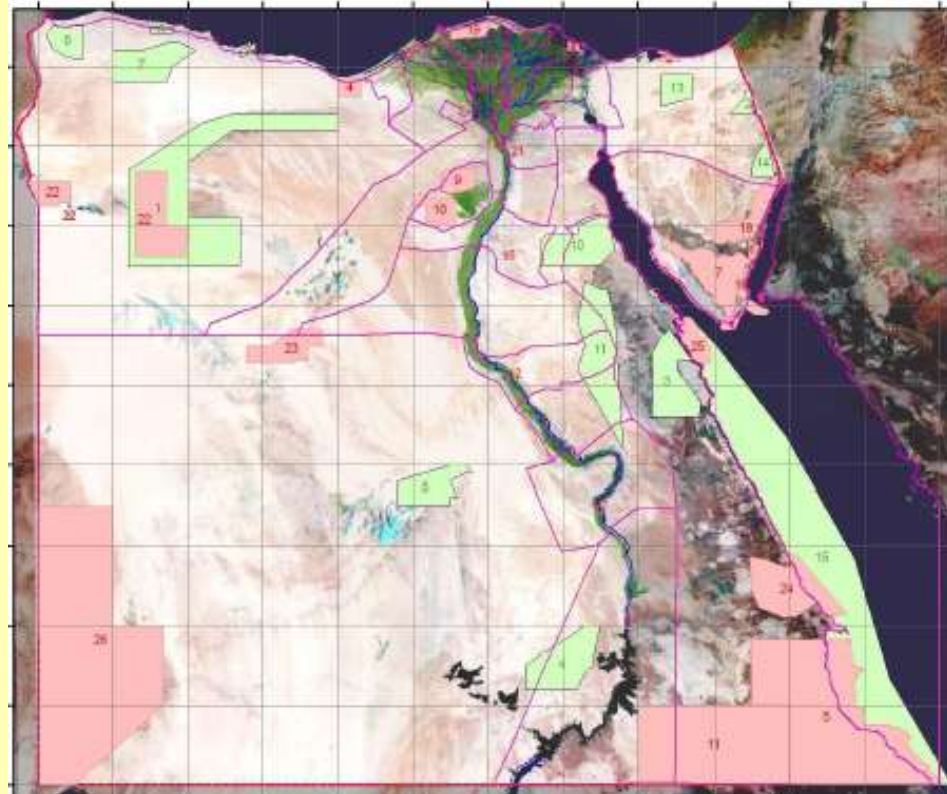
Crucial for bird migration

cross every year



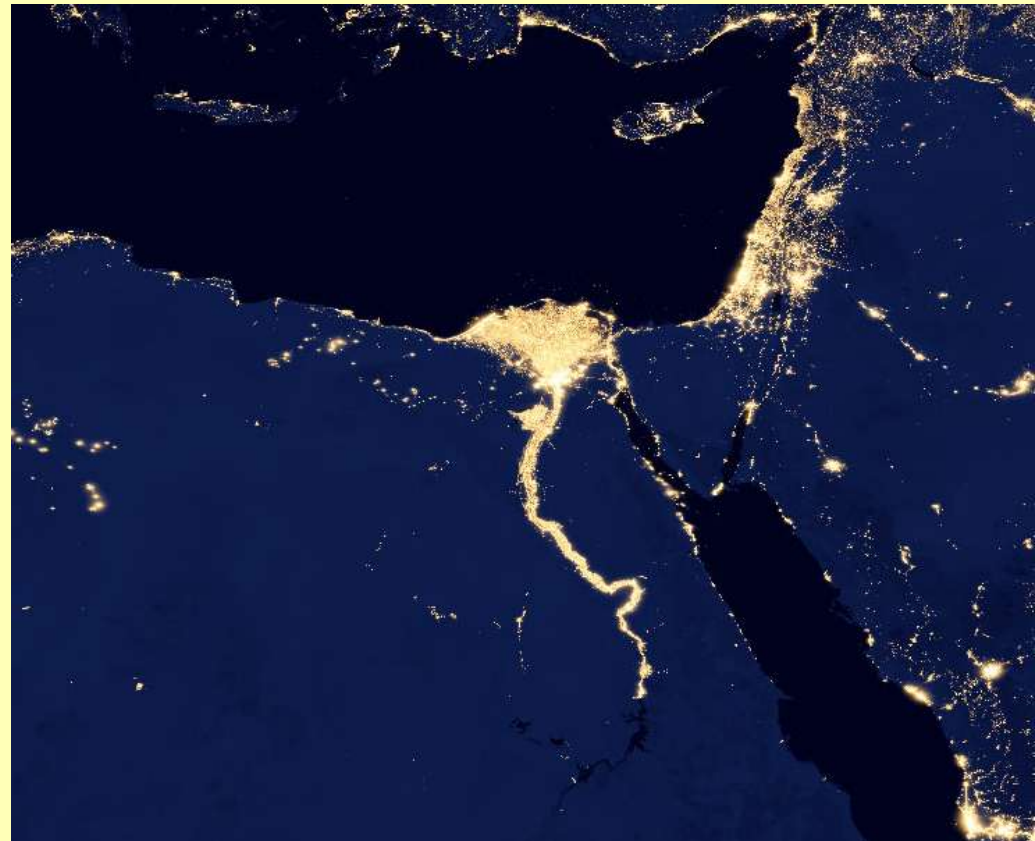
Conservation efforts

- 30 Protected areas (15 % of the country)
 - 2 Biosphere Reserves
 - 3 National Parks
- 1 Natural Heritage Site
- 4 Ramsar sites
- 34 IBAs
- NBSAP



But..

- 90,000,000 inhabitants in 1,000,000 km²
- 90% of the population inhabit 5 % of the total area of the country!



Egypt today:
