4. General information on access to Kartause Ittingen, Switzerland



From Zurich airport take the Swiss Federal Railways train to Frauenfeld (<u>www.sbb.ch</u>). Take a taxi from Frauenfeld to Kartause Ittingen (10 minute drive). The approximate cost for a taxi from Frauenfeld to Kartause Ittingen is 30 CHF.

By car: Motorway A7 with destination "Konstanz, Kreuzlingen, Frauenfeld". Exit Frauenfeld-West, follow brown signposts for 4.5 km.

From Zurich 43 km Zurich Airport 40 km St. Gall 46 km Constance (D) 24 km

5. Visa requirements

Please consult with the nearest Swiss Embassy or Consulate in advance whether you need a visa or any particular documents. Some delegates may require <u>transit visas</u> due to connecting flights. Please, consult as soon as possible with the respective Embassies of those countries whether you will have to obtain a transit visa before starting your trip to Switzerland.

Upon request, the CBD Secretariat will supply Invitation Letters to facilitate the issuance of visas, to be attached to the visa applications.

6. Hotel information



Block bookings at Stiftung Kartause Ittingen have been made for all participants.

Funded participants:

Full board accommodation will be covered by the Secretariat of the CBD. Any additional expenses for items consumed such as wine or beer with meals are to be covered by the participants. Funded participants will be paid a partial Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) for the duration of the meeting plus one additional day to cover other travel costs such as visa and terminal expenses. Funded participants will be requested to provide a photocopy of their passport and an original copy of their boarding pass.

Non-funded participants:

Non-funded participants are requested to send their arrival and departure details to Ponggyun.park@cbd.int (with a copy to Lydia.zemke@cbd.int) by 28 July 2014. Reservations for bed and breakfast will then be confirmed by the Secretariat. However, non-funded participants are responsible for clearing their own bills.

7. Health information

There is currently no health advisory for Switzerland. Please check vaccines required for visa purposes.

8. Official language in Switzerland

The official languages in Switzerland are German, French, Italian and Romansh. Kartause Ittingen is located in the German-speaking Canton of Thurgau. English is spoken in touristic and recreational sites in the larger cities.
