

5. General information on access to Guatemala City



Guatemala City is serviced by the Guatemala City La Aurora International Airport. The airport is situated about 6 km from the city centre.

Taxis are available for travel into the city and the cost is approximately US \$8 - US \$12 and should take approximately 20 minutes. There is an airport shuttle service available for sponsored participants.

There is a departure tax of approximately US \$30.00 that must be paid in cash prior to departure.

The currency in Guatemala is the Quetzal (GTQ). The current exchange rate as at 5 May 2015 is US \$1 = GTQ \$7.74 and \$0 = GTQ \$8.66 (rates are subject to change).
