**2010 BIP development objective:**

a reduction in the rate of biodiversity loss at the global level, through **improved decisions** for the conservation of global biodiversity.

**2010 BIP immediate objective:**

that decisions made by governments and other stakeholders are **better informed** to improve the conservation status of species, habitats, and ecosystems at the global level.

## The project has three key outcomes:

- (1) A 2010 Biodiversity Indicators Partnership generating information useful to decision-makers;
  - (2) Improved global indicators are implemented and available;
  - (3) National governments and regional organizations using and contributing to the improved delivery of global indicators.**

## **Global-National Outputs - 1**

The development of guidelines and other tools to facilitate:

(i) the use of global 2010 indicator methodologies at national and regional levels,

(ii) the use of global 2010 indicators in national and regional-level policy and decision-making.

(iii) increased local, national, and regional data and other contributions to the development of global 2010 indicators,
