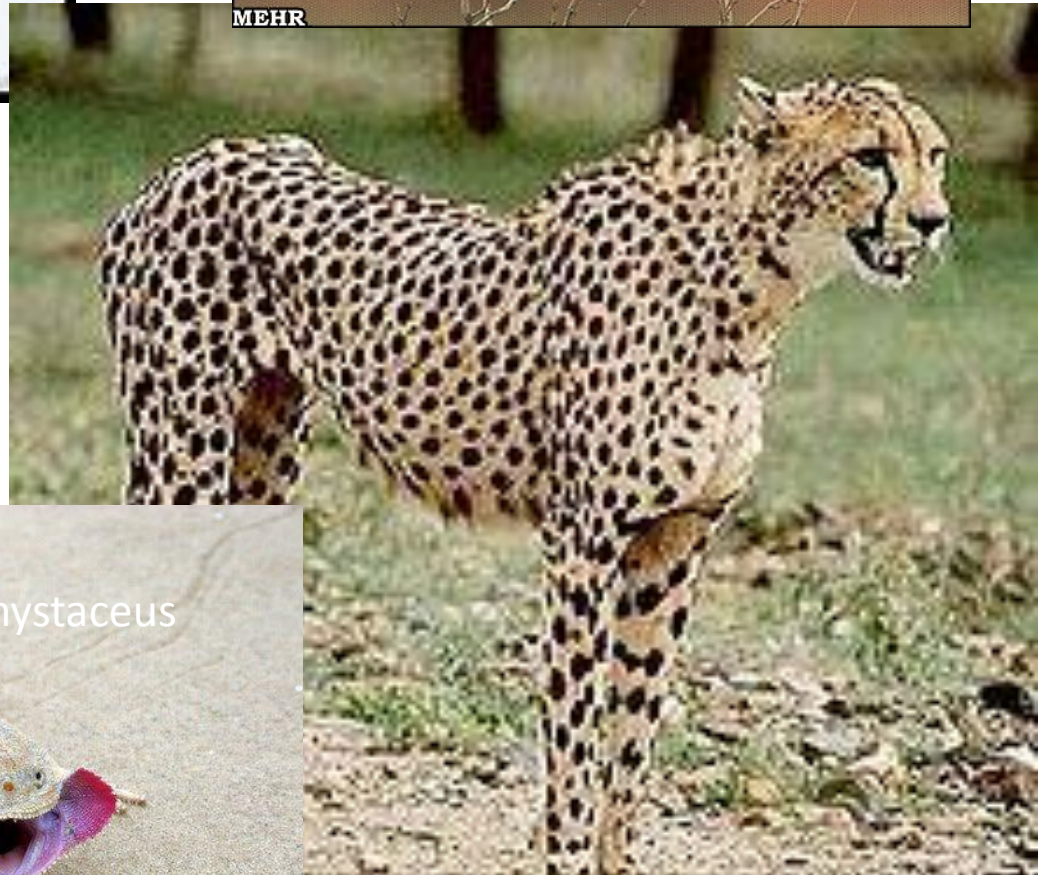

- NBSAP submitted on 2006
- fourth national report submitted on 2010

National Targets

- Awareness of Biodiversity and public participation
- Creation of information and research systems on biodiversity and sustainable use of its resources
- Establishing systematic management of biodiversity conservation strategies

The process for national report

- A proposal was sent to GEF at 2012 but we received no fund

The process was postponed

On November 2013 we requested national budget

Established an advisory committee

(specialized academicians and international consultants)

A National committee (a representative from all the stakeholders)

- Provincial offices of the department of environment
- Ministry of Energy
- Ministry of education

Biodiversity values integrated

1. There is a national project called: "Economic value of environmental resources" in the bureau of sustainable development and economy with these 2 targets:
 - 1) Determining environmental values and costs
 - 2) Empower the environmental protectionwhich is in line with SEEA (System for Integrated Environmental Assessment) and has begun at 2006 and until now, 16 protected sites (exp: Kavir, Haraz, Oshtorakooh national parks) are evaluated.
2. Workshops for the decision makers in the provinces and taking them to site visits
3. Promotion of the green management system which is also inline with target number 3

Incentives reformed

- Paying the whole compensation to the herders if their domestic animals are attacked by the Iranian cheetah and Panthera (It is in progress)
- Increasing the fines related to hunting and illegal fishing
