- Participatory approach
- 2 version: Bahasa Indonesia & English
- Assist by resources person/experts  
(biodiversity specialist, planning agency,  
national scientific institute, environmental  
specialist)

# PROCESS FOR PREPARATION

- General mechanism for preparation of 4NR:
  - Establish Task Force (coordination) and technical team
  - Collect & collate data & info
    1. Collect & review strategic planning (sectoral departments, local governments)
    2. Assess relationship/linking with IBSAP (biodiversity planning and policy)
    3. Use questionnaires to collect data & info for chapter 2 (reviewing IBSAP)
  - Consultation meetings
  - National workshops: kick off, verification process, validation
  - Discussion forum (CHM), mailing list

# Lesson learns

- a format of the report from the secretariat made formulation easier
- Data are scattered in various institutions and insufficient on data series
- the need for more stakeholder involvement in the preparation of the report
- how the formation of stakeholder consultation groups could help to address the lack of up to-date-information
- the challenges of presenting technical information so that it could be more easily understood by policy makers and the public more broadly
- This process raising awareness on the importance of data and information, therefore LIPI has done collect data on status of biodiversity and then published on 2011
- the difficulties of translating the report into one of the official languages of the United Nations
