Overview

The fifth national reports are one of the main sources of information for the mid-term assessment of progress towards in the implementation of the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020

For the mid-term review to be meaningful, and to allow COP to make informed decisions, it will be important that Parties provide their national reports by the **31 March 2014** deadline

As a result it is important that Parties begin to prepare their fifth national reports as soon as possible







Links to other processes

NBSAP development process



The process of preparing the national report should not be seen as an activity undertaken only to respond to a COP request

The process of preparing a national report should respond to national needs and circumstances and can be linked to the NBSAP process





Who should be involved

Generally the preparation of the national report is the responsibility of the national focal point. However the preparation process should also include:

- Relevant ministries and organizations (environment, fisheries, agriculture, mining, finance, education, etc.)
- The ministries in charge of sectoral planning and coordination
- The national focal points of relevant conventions (UNFCCC, UNCCD, Ramsar, etc.)
- Scientific organizations, non-governmental and community organizations and the private sector
