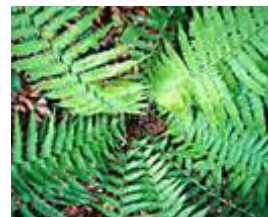




BIG WIN FOR DINARIC ARC

Environmental ministers of six governments signed a joint commitment and national-level commitments for delivering on the CBD PoWPA:

- 13 new areas to be established (7 trans-boundary)
- Review of PA management effectiveness & financing
- Management plans (terrestrial and marine)
- Exchange of information and collaboration



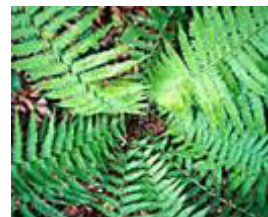

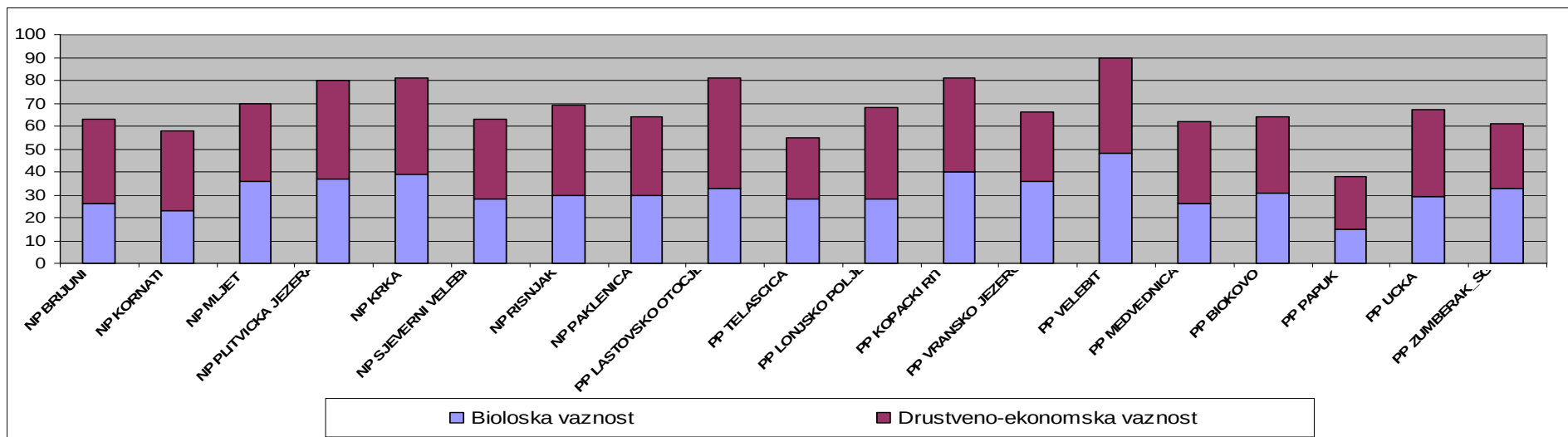

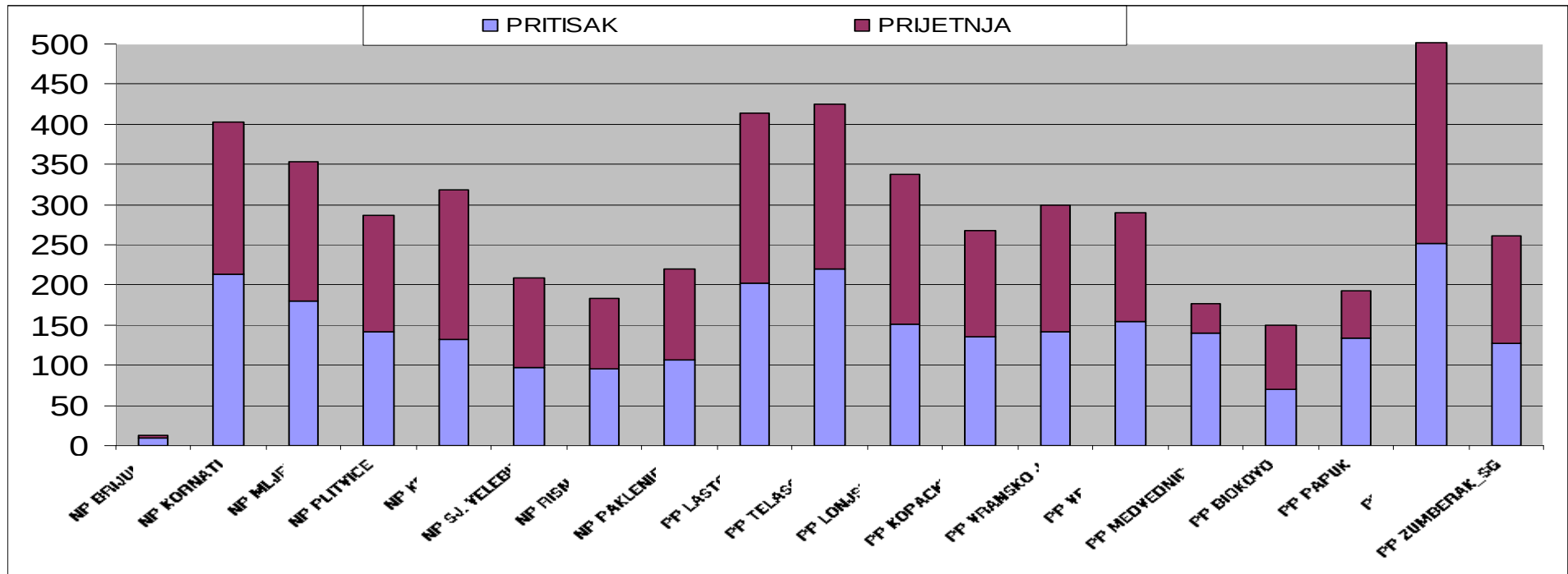

Relative “importance” of protected areas



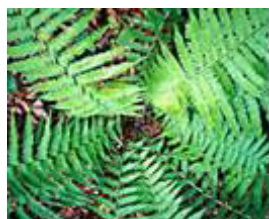
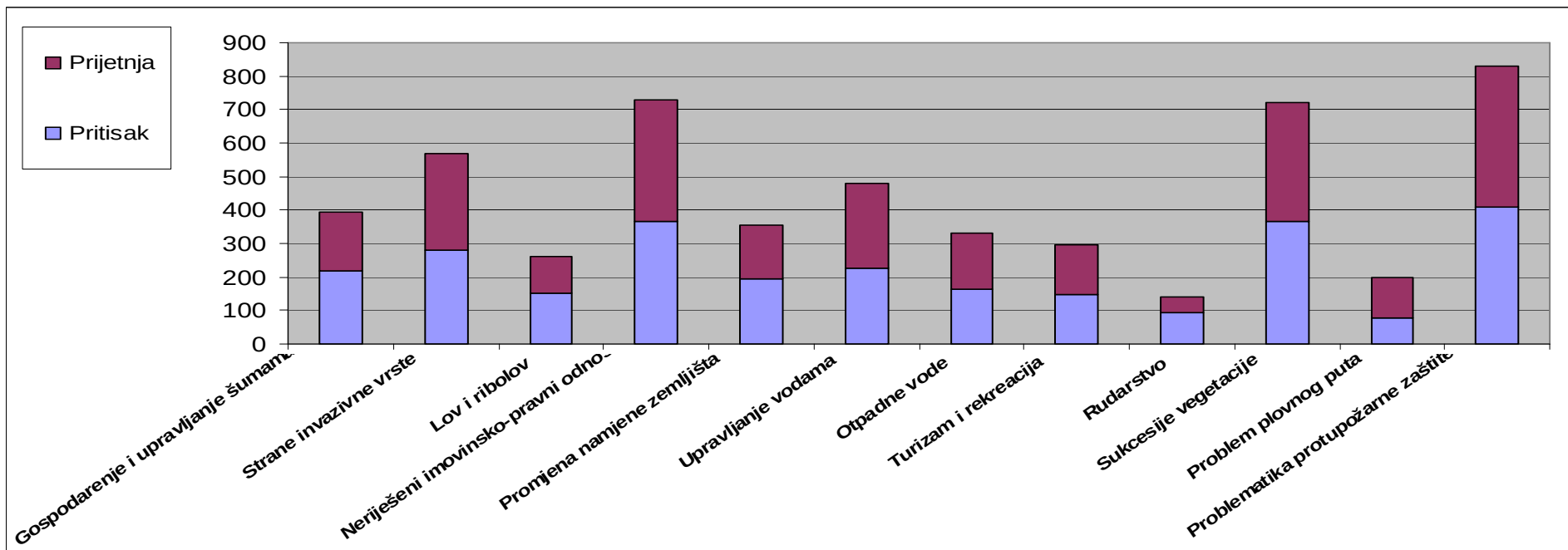


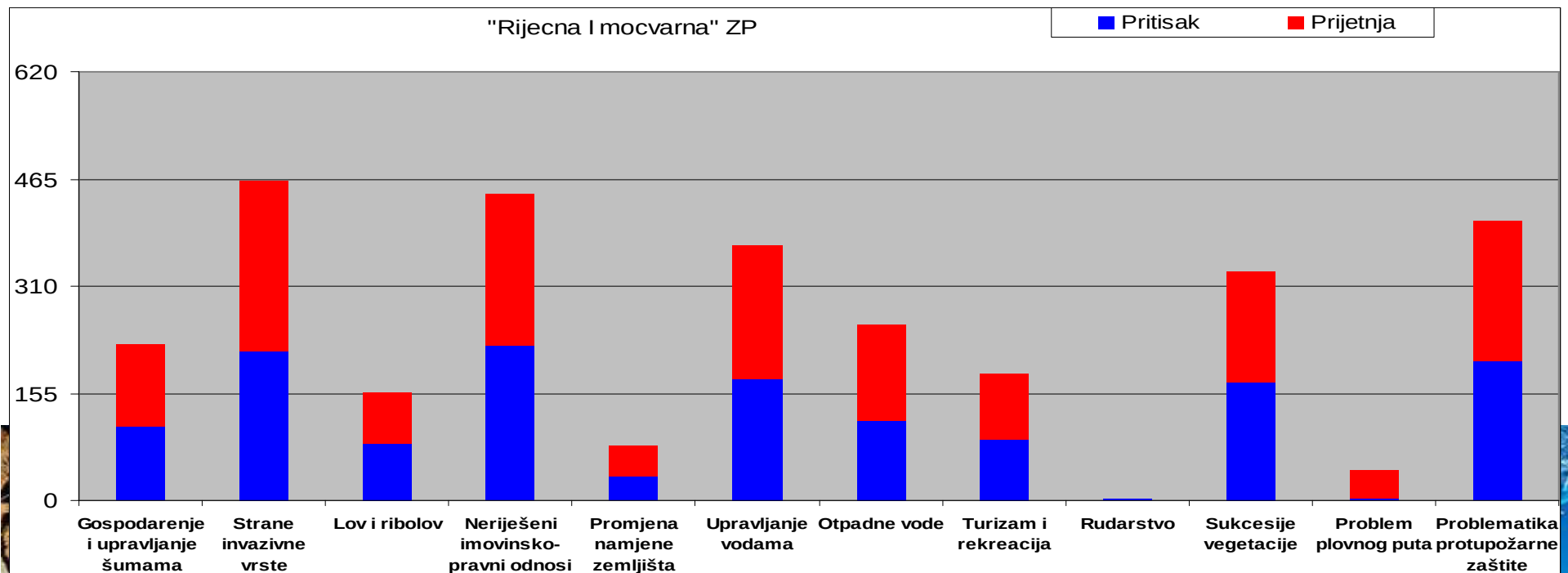
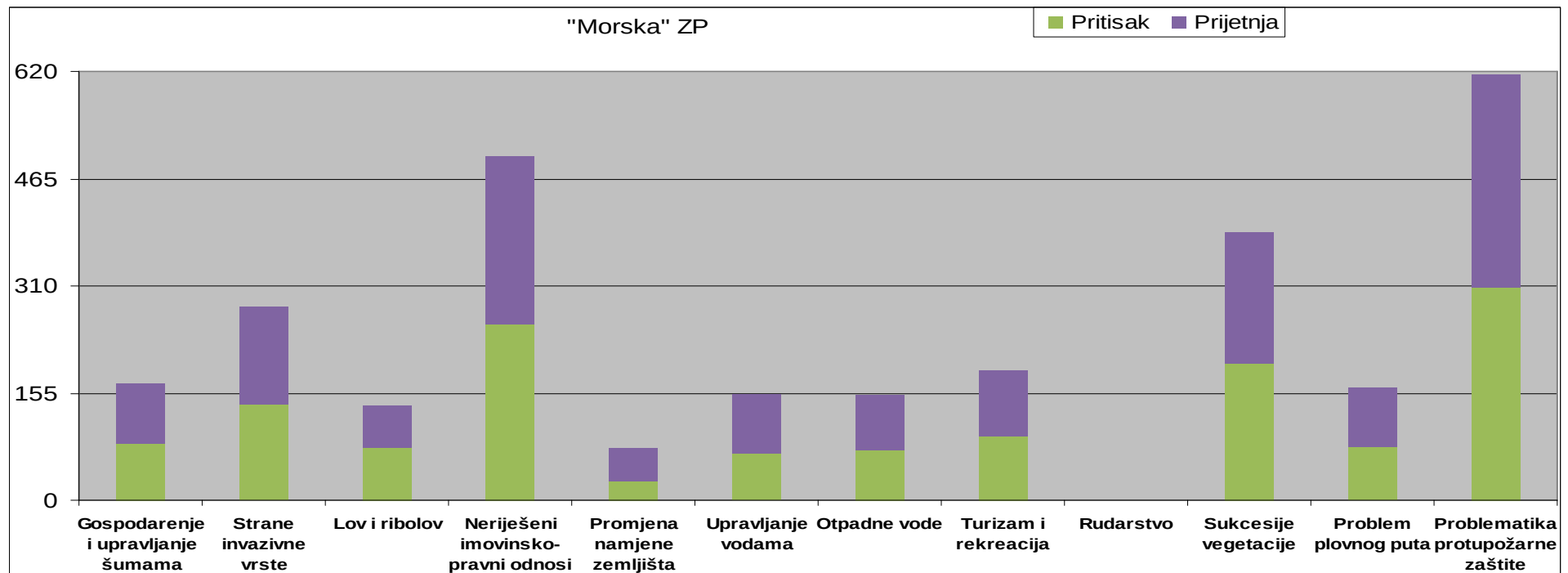
Which Parks are most threatened?





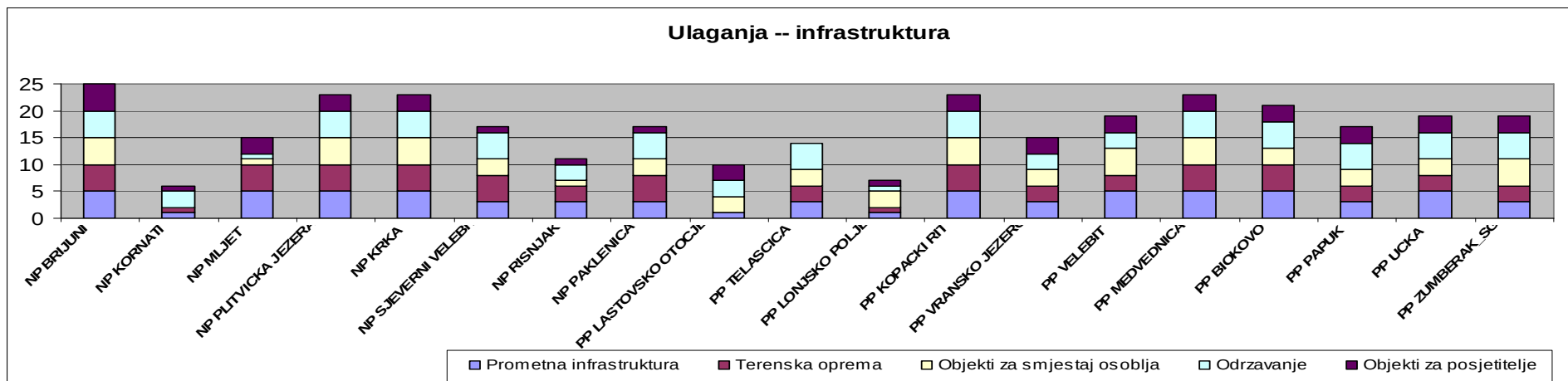
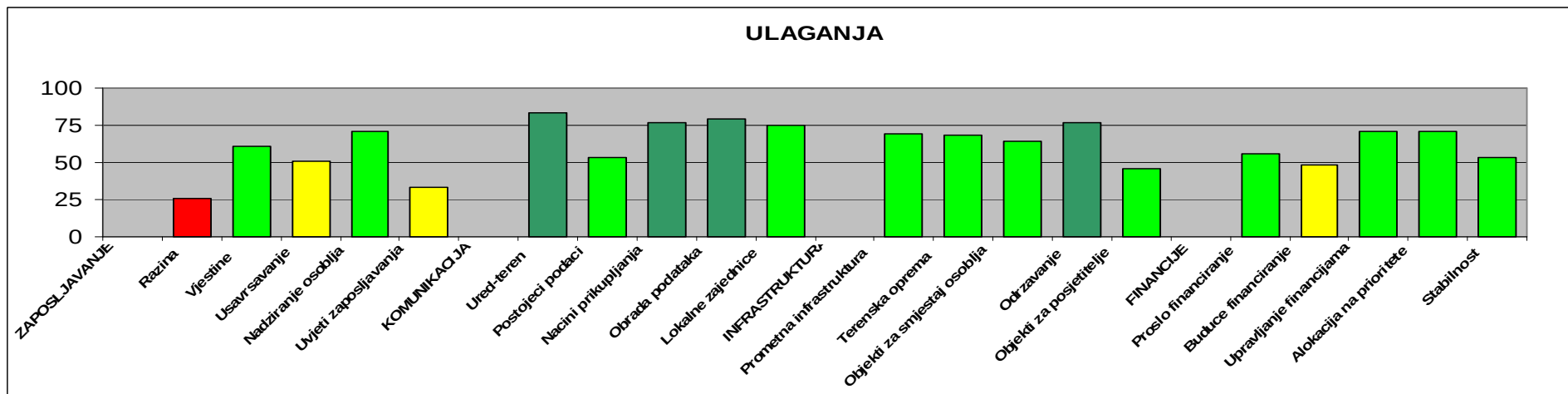

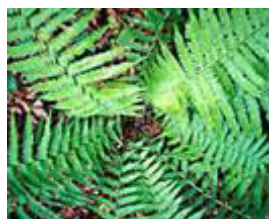
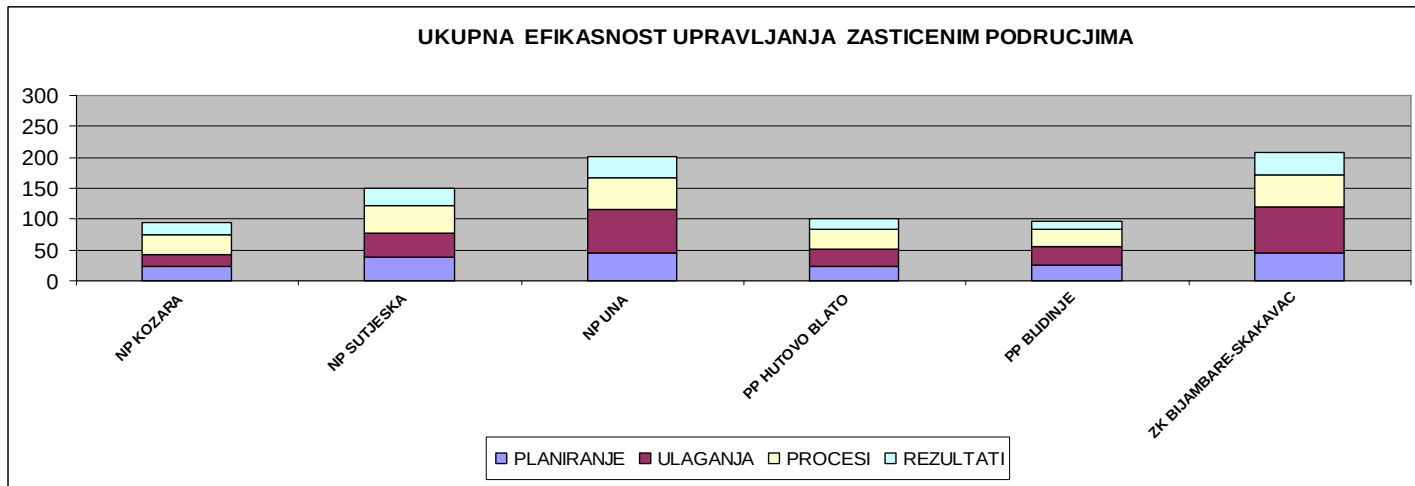
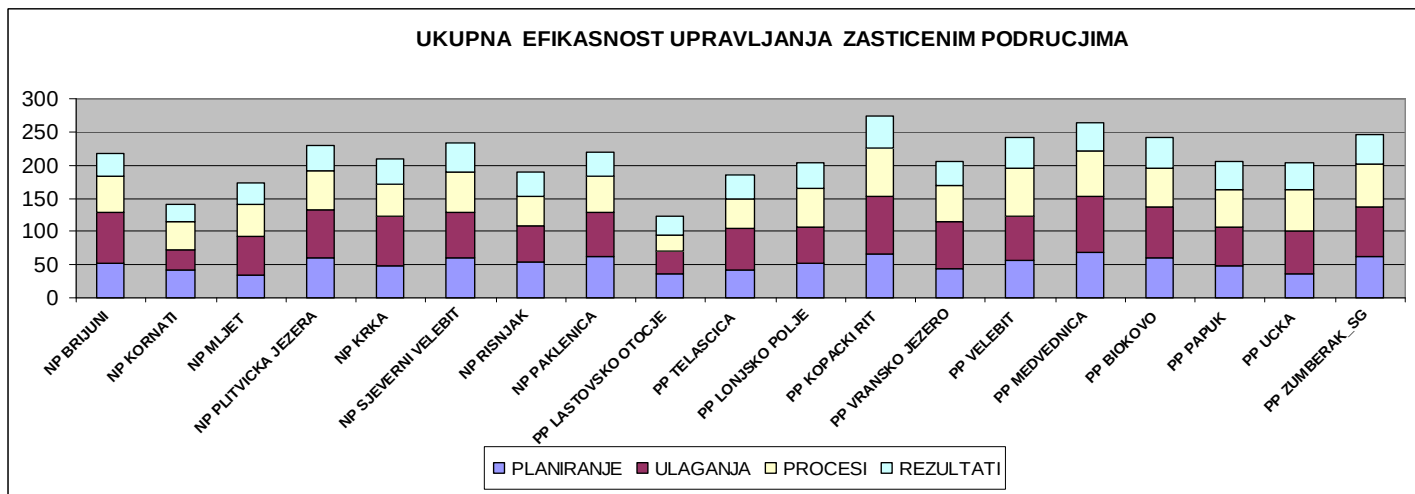


Planning process (SER)
