Para 1 (b) Invites Parties to develop a long-term action plan or reorient relevant existing plans... for the implementation of PoWPA, including appropriate implementation mechanisms,... detailing a list of activities, timelines, budget and responsibilities, based upon the results of key assessments of the programme of work on protected areas, with a view to contributing to the implementation of the Strategic Plan of the Convention and requests the Executive Secretary to submit a report on the preparation of such plans to the Conference of the Parties at its eleventh meeting


Para 10 Invites Parties to:

(a) Develop and implement sustainable finance plans in accordance with national legislation and systems, for protected area systems by 2012 and support individual protected areas ,based on realistic needs assessments and a diversified portfolio of traditional and innovative financial mechanisms;

(b) **Timely and appropriately** use the protected-area biodiversity allocations of the fifth replenishment period of the Global Environment Facility, as well as bilateral, multilateral and other financial support relevant for protected areas **using their action plan** for implementing the programme of work on protected areas **as the basis for accessing funds**;

Para 13. The COP *Urges* the **Global Environment Facility and its Implementing Agencies** to streamline their delivery for expeditious and proportionate disbursement and **to align the projects to national action plans** for the programme of work on protected **areas for appropriate**, **focused**, **sufficient and harmonious interventions and continuity of projects**


