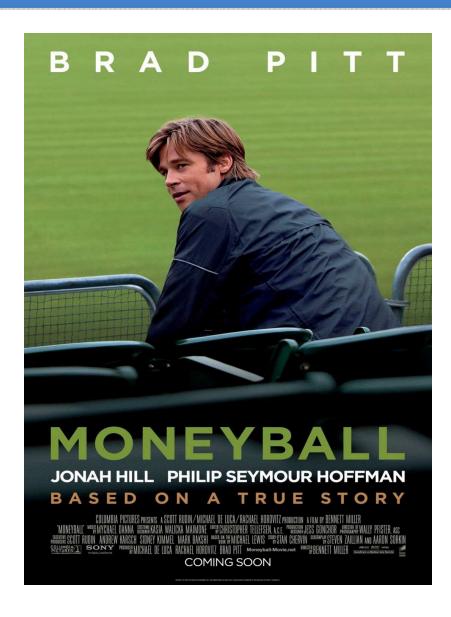

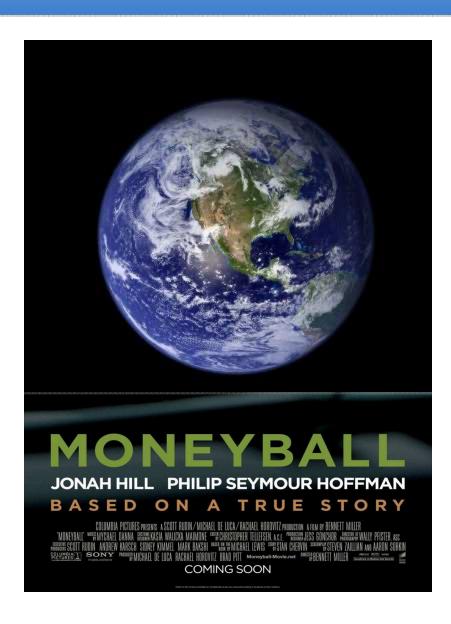

Summary of COP 10 X/31 Decisions

Develop a long-term action plan or reorient, as appropriate, relevant existing plans, taking into account national circumstances and priorities, involving all relevant stakeholders including indigenous and local communities, for the implementation of the programme of work on protected areas, including appropriate implementation mechanisms, and, where appropriate, detailing list of activities, timelines, budget and responsibilities, based upon the results of key assessments of the programme of work on protected areas, with a view to contributing to the implementation of the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020 and requests the Executive Secretary to submit a report on the preparation of such plans to the Conference of the Parties at its eleventh meeting;



Summary of COP 10 X/31 Decisions

Notes progress in regional initiatives and invites Parties to foster the formation of such initiatives and formulate regional action plans, where appropriate through national focal points for the programme of work on protected areas in collaboration with the IUCN World Commission on Protected Areas and other conservation organizations, based on country action plans for implementation of the programme of work on protected areas and other relevant programmes of work, and through regional technical support networks, to coordinate funding, technical support, exchange of experiences and capacity-building for implementing the programme of work on protected areas;

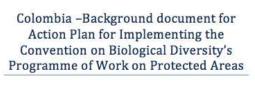

Donor roundtables



Steps to a donor roundtable:

1. Complete a detailed PoWPA Action Plan.

prioritized actions in the plan are detailed (means includes timelines, funding required, agency responsible, and based on key assessments) and similar for each country it will be easier to cooperate regionally and develop a Regional PoWPA Action Plan.

When appropriate develop a Regional PoWPA Action Plan.

Determine a detailed set of regional priority actions to be done regionally. Identify how to strategically make the best use of funding and capacity building.

- 2. Use the National and Regional Action Plan to access your GEF 5 allocations
- 3. Co-host a donor roundtable with LifeWeb. With the regionally and nationally prioritized actions and using the domestic contributions plus the GEF funding we can use the roundtable process to coordinate and leverage additional financial, as well as human/technical resources and partnerships for implementation.
