

Master's degree

Based on PA assessments results (sites and/or systems of PA), different trainings are proposed to « stakeholders » involved in PoWPA implementation...

- 1) Young PA managers (and partners = NGOs, private sector...): under 30 year old and with 2-5 year professional experience:
- Master's Degree on Protected Areas Management
- Developed with the Senghor University (Alexandria, Egypt) in partnership with the Francophonie.
- Two years (M1 + M2) conducting to an internationally recognized diploma.
- M1 is about environmental general issues (biology, economy, laws and regulations, international conventions, impact assessments, statistics, landuse planning...)

Master's Degree on Protected Areas Management (following):

- M2 is a one-year specialization : PA management, climate changes, environmental education, funding...
- Current Master = 2011 2013: 45 students
- A majority of them comes from PA
- One day specific training course is planned on the CBD + PoWPA (introduction and generalities)

2) Young PA managers (and partners = NGOs, private sector...): between 30 and 40 year old and with 5 - 15 year professional experience:



University Diploma on PA management:

- Developed with the Senghor University (Alexandria, Egypt) in partnership with the Francophonie.
- Twice a year (Feb-March and Nov-Dec)
- 8 week training course (including 2 weeks on the ground)
- A program adapted to West/Central Africa managers' profile (management tools, PA planning, sustainable funding, GIS, wildlife monitoring, laws and regulations, land-use planning, economy, specificities of savannah ecology...)

University Diploma on PA management (following):

- Currently 20 students trained in Ouagadougou
- Half of them working for a national parks department
- One day training course on the CBD + PoWPA

3) All managers and partners:



Short term training courses:

- One to two weeks
- On request Specifically designed for a group (one or several countries)
- Mostly about PA management technical issues (tools, planning, funding, monitoring, mining...)
- Done by Papaco's staff and/or a consultant
- Easy to organize and to repeat
- Partnerships with various NGOs

4) All managers and partners:



E-learning (under construction)

- In cooperation with the Senghor University (recognition of the diploma)
- The objective is to increase the number of trainees
- And to allow a multiple year cursus for those who can't leave their position for 2 years (Master) or 2 months (DU)
- Open to all PA managers and partners with adequate training level, all over Africa
- To be developed in both French and English
- In partnership with WCPA and the CBD secretariat?
